U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT BRIEF FILED

Daniel L. Goelzer, General Counsel of the Commission, today announced that the Commission filed a friend-of-the-court brief with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit in Consolidated Gold Fields PLC, et al. v. Anglo American Corporation of South Africa Limited. The case involves a tender offer made by a foreign company for the shares of another foreign company, 97.5% of which are held by foreign residents. The brief argues that since the bidder sent offering materials to persons who were known by the bidder to be foreign-based agents for U.S. resident shareholders, a U.S. court has subject-matter jurisdiction over an allegation that the offering documents violate U.S. antifraud laws. However, the brief also argues that on the facts of this case, a court must abstain from granting relief that would enjoin the tender offer worldwide. (Press Release 88-115)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION FILED AGAINST HARVEY A. DOLINER

The Commission yesterday filed a civil action in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York seeking permanent injunctive and other equitable relief against Harvey Alan Doliner. The Complaint alleges that Doliner violated the antifraud and tender offer provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 in connection with his purchases of Gartner Group, Inc. stock. It further alleges that as an executive vice president with Saatchi & Saatchi Holdings (USA), Inc., Doliner traded in the common stock of Gartner after learning material, nonpublic information regarding his employer's interest in acquiring Gartner.

Simultaneously, Doliner, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, consented to a proposed Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief enjoining and restraining him from further violations of the above-mentioned provisions, ordering him to disgorge profits of \$22,250.00, and to pay a penalty of \$22,250.00 under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. (SEC v. Harvey Alan Doliner, USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 88-Civ 8806, RJW). (LR-11940) The San Francisco Branch Office announced that on December 2 the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado issued Orders of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief against eight of the remaining defendants in a case involving the reorganization and promotion of two public "shell" corporations, Dynapac, Inc. and Sedona Corp. Defendants include Denver-based stockbrokers Mark W. Sharpe and Victoria E. Yates; a Denver financial consulting firm, National Financial Services, Inc., its principal, James A. Howe, and its former associates, Patrick J. Murray and Stephen Rosenbaum; and a previously registered Reno, Nevada investment adviser, Silver Baron, Inc., and its principal, Elliott R. Pearson.

The Orders enjoin defendants, except Murray and Rosenbaum, from future violations of the antifraud provisions; each, except Silver Baron and Pearson, is also enjoined from future violations of the registration and anti-manipulation provisions. Howe, Murray, Rosenbaum, and National Financial are enjoined from violating or aiding and abetting violations of the broker-dealer registration provisions, and Howe is enjoined from violating the issuer-accounting and stock-ownership reporting provisions. Defendants consented to the orders without admitting or denying the allegations. The Order requires Howe to pay \$30,000 in disgorgement; Murray is obligated to pay \$5,000. (SEC v. Dynapac, Inc., et al., DCO, Civil Action No. 87-Z-1130). (LR-11930)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PRUDENTIAL-BACHE GLOBAL FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 6, 1989 to request a hearing on an application filed by Prudential-Bache Global Fund, Inc. and Prudential-Bache Research Fund, Inc. for an order exempting them from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act to permit them to invest in equity and convertible debt securities issued by foreign securities corporations engaged in securities-related businesses under certain conditions.
