COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC OFFICE OF MUNICIPAL SECURITIES ANNOUNCES DEPARTURE OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR GOLDEN

The Commission's Office of Municipal Securities today announced that Deputy Director Susan M. Golden will be departing the Commission on May 2, 1997 after two years of service as Deputy Director. Prior to joining the Office of Municipal Securities, Ms. Golden had served with the Commission as a staff attorney in the Division of Enforcement.

Paul Maco, Director of the Office of Municipal Securities, said, "Susan's efforts were instrumental in establishing the Office of Municipal Securities and making it an effective resource for both the Commission and the municipal finance community. We will all miss her energy and enthusiasm."

Ms. Golden had also been acting Ombudsman for Municipal Securities, working together with Charlotte Buford until designation of a permanent Ombudsman. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

REGISTERED REPRESENTATIVE CHARGED WITH MISAPPROPRIATION OF CUSTOMER FUNDS AND OTHER FRAUDULENT CONDUCT

The Commission announced that it filed a complaint today in federal court in Manhattan charging Joseph C. Kane, Jr. (Kane) of Greenwich, Connecticut, a registered representative, with defrauding his customers by either misappropriating or investing without authorization nearly \$600,000 of his customers' cash or securities between January 1989 and April 1996. According to the complaint, on at least one occasion Kane repaid one defrauded customer with funds he fraudulently obtained from another customer.

As a result of the foregoing, the Commission alleges that Kane violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. The Commission seeks a Final Judgment permanently enjoining Kane from future violations of these antifraud provisions. In addition, the Commission seeks a verified accounting of all misappropriated funds, disgorgement of all ill-gotten gains, plus prejudgment interest thereon, and civil penalties. CHARLES ROSE, A SALESMAN FOR OFFSHORE FINANCIAL CORPORATION, PLEADS GUILTY

The Commission and the United States Attorney for the Northern District of Texas announced that on April 21, in Dallas, Texas, Charles E. Rose, a salesman for Offshore Financial Corporation (Offshore), entered a guilty plea to one count of concealing a felony. Previously, William D. Brosseau and Kenneth W. McKay each pleaded guilty to securities fraud in connection with their operation of Offshore. The indictments had charged Brosseau and McKay with operating a telephone boiler room, lying to investors about revenue projections, and misusing investor money. The charge against Rose carries a maximum penalty of three years' imprisonment; however, Rose may be granted probation for cooperating with government investigators.

The criminal charges are based on the same activities alleged in a civil injunctive action brought by the Commission on September 20, 1996. The Commission's complaint alleged that Brosseau, McKay and others fraudulently raised nearly \$8 million from at least 200 investors in 28 states for the purpose of investing in oil and gas wells. J.R. CONSULTING CONSENTS TO INJUNCTION

On April 24, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia against J.R. Consulting, Inc. The complaint alleges that J.R. Consulting, a Miami-based electrical accessories corporation, failed to make available to the investing public current and accurate information about its financial condition and results of operations through the filing of periodic reports with the Commission as required by the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Specifically, the complaint alleges that J.R. Consulting has not filed its annual report on Form 10-K for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1996, three quarterly reports on Form 10-Q for the fiscal quarters ended December 31, 1996, September 30, 1996 and March 31, 1996, and three Notifications of Late Filing with respect to its delinquent reports. The Commission seeks to compel J.R. Consulting to file its delinquent periodic reports and to enjoin J.R. Consulting from further violations of Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-25, 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder. Simultaneously with the filing of the Commission's complaint, J.R. Consulting consented to the entry of a Final Judgment granting the

relief sought by the Commission and admitted that it had not filed the periodic reports as described above. [SEC v. J.R. Consulting Inc., Case No. 97-CV-00834, D.D.C., April 24, 1997] (LR-15350)
