ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

REGISTERED PRINCIPAL CHARGED WITH WIRE FRAUD

The United States Attorney for the Southern District of Texas announced that on May 21, 1997, Juan Carlos Martinez was charged by a criminal complaint with wire fraud (18 U.S.C. § 1343). The complaint charges that Martinez, an officer, registered principal and registered representative of MBM Investment Corp. (MBM), a broker-dealer registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission, diverted more than \$130,000 in client funds from MBM accounts for his own benefit. The complaint further charges that Martinez made unauthorized trades in client accounts, including the sale of conservative investments and the purchase of risky options and speculative bonds issued by a Bermuda-based company attempting to establish retail clothing stores in Russia. The complaint

charges that these unauthorized transactions resulted in losses of more than \$10 million to MBM clients. According to the complaint, Martinez concealed his unauthorized activities in MBM client accounts by providing MBM clients with fabricated documents, including falsified account statements. [U.S. v. REGISTERED REPRESENTATIVE PLEADS GUILTY TO MONEY LAUNDERING

The United States Attorney for the Southern District of Texas announced that on May 20, 1997 Michael Anthony Chmiel pled guilty to 19 counts of Money Laundering. The indictment charged that Chmiel, a registered representative at MBM Investment Corp., a broker-dealer the United States Securities registered with and Commission, had wealthy Mexican clients who owned shares in mutual funds managed by Guinness Flight Funds Managers of Guernsey (Guinness Flight), a fund manager located in the British Channel Islands. In his Plea Agreement, Chmiel pled quilty to charges that he forged the signatures of four foreign clients in order to use their Guinness Flight holding as collateral on \$2 million in loans from Guinness Mahon Guernsey Limited (Guinness Mahon), a bank with its principal place of business also located in the British Channel Islands. Chmiel then transferred loan proceeds first to a Cayman Islands bank account he controlled and subsequently to various bank accounts in the United States. Chmiel spent approximately \$1.3 million of the funds, including \$450,000 for the purchase of a house in Houston. In the Plea Agreement, Chmiel agrees to make full restitution to all victims of his offense. [U.S. v. Michael Anthony Chmiel, H-96-263, USDC, SD/TX] (LR-15408)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE RIVERFRONT FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Riverfront Funds, Inc. (Company), et al. for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit the Company to transfer all the assets and liabilities of certain of its series to The Riverfront Funds (Trust) in exchange for shares of corresponding series of the Trust. An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that American Government Term Trust Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22736 - July 8)

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Briar Funds Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22737 - July 8)

THE ANDEAN FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that The Andean Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22738 - July 8)

REICH & TANG DISTRIBUTORS L.P., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Reich & Tang Distributors L.P., et al. under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order permits certain terminating series of Equity Securities Trust (Trust), a unit investment trust, to sell portfolio securities to certain new series of the Trust. (Rel. IC-22739 - July 8)

BARTLETT MANAGEMENT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 4 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bartlett Management Trust for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22740 - July 8)

INVESTMENT ADVISERS ACT RELEASES

ERNST & YOUNG INVESTMENT ADVISERS LLP

An order has been issued on an application filed by Ernst & Young Investment Advisers LLP under Section 203A(c) of the Investment Advisers Act granting an exemption from Section 203A(a) of the Act. The order permits Ernst & Young Investment Advisers LLP to remain registered with the SEC as an investment adviser. (Rel. IA-1641 - July 8)

ARTHUR ANDERSEN FINANCIAL ADVISERS

An order has been issued on an application filed by Arthur Andersen Financial Advisers under Section 203A(c) of the Investment Advisers Act granting an exemption from Section 203A(a) of the Act. The order permits Arthur Andersen Financial Advisers to remain registered with the SEC as an investment adviser. (Rel. IA-1642 - July 8)

KPMG INVESTMENT ADVISORS

An order has been issued on an application filed by KPMG Investment Advisors under Section 203A(c) of the Investment Advisers Act granting an exemption from Section 203A(a) of the Act. The order permits KPMG Investment Advisors to remain registered with the SEC as an investment adviser. (Rel. IA-1643 - July 8)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Delta Clearing Corp.</u> (SR-DCC-97-02) that modifies Delta's procedures for options trading. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 7. (Rel. 34-38796)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-97-19) and granted accelerated approval to Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 to the proposed rule change filed by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> relating to the listing and trading of indexed term notes. (Rel. 34-38819)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> to clarify its SuperMAX and Enhanced SuperMAX price improvement rules in light of the Exchange's recent transition to trading in sixteenths (SR-CHX-97-18) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 7. (Rel. 34-38816)

The <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-97-29) which became effective upon filing. The proposed rule change relates to its Fee Reduction Program for market-maker transaction fees, floor broker fees, and member dues; and its Customer "Large" Trade Discount Program. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 7. (Rel. 34-38817)

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA V. MICHAEL ANTHONY CHMIEL, H-96-263, USDC, SD/TX

The United States Attorney for the Southern District of Texas announced that on May 20, 1997 Michael Anthony Chmiel ("Chmiel"), pled guilty to 19 counts of Money Laundering (18 U.S.C. § 1956(a)(2)(B)(i) and 2(b)).

The indictment charged that Chmiel, a registered representative at MBM Investment Corp., a broker-dealer registered with the United States Securities and Exchange Commission, had wealthy Mexican clients who owned shares in mutual funds managed by Guinness Flight Funds Managers of Guernsey ("Guinness Flight"), a fund manager located in the British Channel Islands. In his Plea Agreement, Chmiel pled guilty to charges that he forged the signatures of four foreign clients in order to use their Guinness Flight holding as collateral on \$2 million in loans from Guinness Mahon Guernsey Limited ("Guinness Mahon"), a bank with its principal place of business also located in the British Channel Islands. Chmiel then transferred loan proceeds first to a Cayman Islands bank account he controlled and subsequently to various bank accounts in the United States. Chmiel spent approximately \$1.3 million of the funds, including \$450,000 for the purchase of a house in Houston. In the Plea Agreement, Chmiel agrees to make full restitution to all victims of his offense.

Chmiel will be sentenced by United States District Judge Norman Black on August 8, 1997.

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA V. JUAN CARLOS MARTINEZ, H-97-476, USDC, SD/TX

The United States Attorney for the Southern District of Texas announced that on May 21, 1997, Juan Carlos Martinez ("Martinez") was charged by a criminal complaint with wire fraud (18 U.S.C. § 1343). The complaint charges that Martinez, an officer, registered principal and registered representative of MBM Investment Corp. ("MBM"), a broker-dealer registered with the United States Securities and Exchange Commission, diverted more than \$130,000 in client funds from MBM accounts for his own benefit. The complaint further charges that Martinez made unauthorized trades in client accounts, including the sale of conservative investments and the purchase of risky options and speculative bonds issued by a Bermuda-based company attempting to establish retail clothing stores in Russia. The complaint charges that these unauthorized transactions resulted in losses of more than \$10 million to MBM clients. According to the complaint, Martinez concealed his unauthorized activities in MBM client accounts by providing MBM clients with fabricated documents, including falsified account statements.
