## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

## LORI RICHARDS TO TESTIFY

Lori Richards, Director of the Office of Compliance Inspections and Examinations, will testify on behalf of the Commission on October 8, 1997, before the House Subcommittee on Financial Institutions and Consumer Credit concerning the Commission's examination oversight of securities firms affiliated with banks. The hearing will begin at 10:00 a.m. in Room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building.

CHIEF ACCOUNTANT SELECTS AN INTERNATIONAL PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTING FELLOW AND IS SEEKING CANDIDATES FOR THREE OTHER PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTING FELLOW POSITIONS

The Commission's Office of the Chief Accountant recently selected D.J. Gannon of Deloitte & Touche to serve as a Professional Accounting Fellow, in the area of international accounting, for a two year term beginning in October 1997. Currently, Mr. Gannon is a Manager in the national office of Deloitte & Touche LLP in Wilton, Connecticut. Mr. Gannon will join the current Professional Accounting Fellows -- Ms. Donna L. Coallier, formerly of Coopers & Lybrand LLP; Mr. Jeffrey N. Jones, formerly of KPMG Peat Marwick LLP; Mr. Armando Pimentel, formerly of Deloitte & Touche LLP; Mr. Cody L. Smith, formerly of Price Waterhouse LLP; and Mr. Robert Uhl, formerly of Deloitte & Touche LLP.

At the Commission, the newly selected Professional Accounting Fellow will work with the Chief Accountant and will focus primarily on international accounting, reporting, and auditing issues. Significant responsibilities will include reviewing and evaluating proposed international accounting and auditing standards and consulting on interpretive matters relating to the application of non-US generally accepted accounting principles in documents filed with the Commission.

The Commission also announced that it is now accepting applications for three Professional Accounting Fellow positions in the Office of the Chief Accountant. This highly successful program is designed to

provide outstanding opportunities for personal development and career enhancement. During their two year term, Fellows work directly with the Chief Accountant, and are involved in the study and development of rule proposals under the Federal securities laws, liaison with professional accounting standard-setting bodies, and consultation with registrants on accounting and reporting matters. Of the three Fellows who will be selected in early 1998, the Chief Accountant would like to select one individual with both a background in accounting for financial instruments and experience with financial institutions other than banks, such as insurance companies. In addition, familiarity with accounting for business combinations, stock compensation, and consolidations enhances an applicant's qualifications.

Applicants should have a minimum of eight years' experience in public accounting or its equivalent, with at least two years as a manager. They should be thoroughly familiar with technical accounting and auditing literature as well as with current issues confronting the profession.

Applicants are required to submit background information and an eight- to ten-page essay on a current accounting or auditing issue of interest to the applicant and the Commission staff. They must submit a resume or a completed Standard Form 171, "Personnel Qualification Statement," and should include at least two letters of recommendation from non-relatives. Applications must be submitted by December 31. ## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COURT AWARDS \$7.8 MILLION IN SEC v. KS RESOURCES, ET AL.

On September 25, the United States District Court for the Central District of California entered an Order Granting Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's Motion for Summary Judgment Against KS Resources and Weststar Exploration, Inc.; Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief which permanently enjoined KS Resources (KS) and Weststar Exploration, Inc. (Weststar) from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Court ordered KS to pay disgorgement of \$3,292,980 and prejudgment interest of \$321,941.09 and Weststar to pay disgorgement of \$3,861,004 and prejudgment interest of \$377,474.45, totalling \$7,853,399.54.

The Commission's complaint alleged that KS, Weststar, and other defendants perpetrated a Ponzi-like scheme when they fraudulently sold oil and gas limited partnerships from May 1993 through December 19, 1995. The Commission further alleged that the fraudulent scheme raised approximately \$34,934,000 from investors, many of whom are elderly. The Court found that KS acted as general partner for 27 of the 29 limited partnerships and that Weststar acted as the operator for the 29 limited partnerships. [SEC v. KS Resources, et al., Civil Action No. 95-8608 WDK, AJWx, C.D. Cal.] (LR-15525)

JOHN BRINK, DEFENDANT IN A SEC ACTION, INDICTED ON STATE FELONY CHARGES

On September 26, John Patrick Brink was indicted by a grand jury in Harris County, Texas, on two counts of securities fraud and two counts of misapplication of fiduciary funds. Brink was charged with failure to disclose material information to investors who purchased units in ventures sponsored by Energy Service Co., Inc., including, among other things, information that investors' funds were used for purposes unrelated to those for which they had invested, and that the company had insufficient funds to pay back investment funds owed to previous investors.

The indictments are based on activities alleged against Brink in a civil action brought by the Commission on March 27, 1997, against Enserco, Inc., d/b/a Energy Service Company, Brink, Anthony J. Leo and Frank Bravo, Jr. The Commission's complaint alleges, among other things, that the defendants raised approximately \$3.6 million from investors for the purpose of purchasing oil field equipment and pipe. Enserco was to resell the equipment and return a portion of the profits to investors. In fact, according to the complaint, Brink operated an undisclosed "Ponzi" scheme whereby monies contributed by new investors were paid as purported profits to previous investors. Further, the complaint alleges that Brink misappropriated investors' funds. The Commission's action is continuing. [State of Texas v. # IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission is publishing notice of a proposed rule change by the Chicago Board Options Exchange that has become effective pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-CBOE-97-47). The proposed rule change relates to the CBOE's assessment of Exchange fees that are charged when a person submits a bid to receive an Option Trading Permit (OTP) from the OTP lease pool. The changes to the corporate documents reflect, among other things, proposed changes to the corporate structure of the NASD and its subsidiaries.
