ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PINNACLE MICRO, INC. AND FORMER OFFICERS CONSENT TO CEASE AND DESIST ORDER FOR ACCOUNTING VIOLATIONS; ANOTHER OFFICER CONSENTS TO INJUNCTION

On October 3, the Commission instituted a cease and desist order against Pinnacle Micro, Inc., an Irvine, California-based manufacturer of optical disk drives, Scott A. Blum, the former Executive Vice President of Sales and Marketing, and Lilia Craig, the former Vice-President of Finance. The cease and desist order alleges that Pinnacle improperly recorded revenue from optical disk drives shipped after the close of its December 31, 1993 financial reporting period (post-period shipments); inconsistently accounted for sales of certain electronic chips in its third quarter ended September 30, 1993; and capitalized certain non-recurring engineering expenditures that should have been charged to expense as research and development costs in its third quarter ended September 30, 1995.

In addition, the Commission found that Blum was aware of Pinnacle's post-period shipments and failed to take any steps to terminate the practice. Blum suggested the use of, and failed to inform Pinnacle's independent auditor about, the inconsistent accounting for the sales of the electronic chips. The Commission also found that Craig failed to inform Pinnacle's independent auditor about Pinnacle's post-period shipments. Pinnacle, Blum, and Craig each consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to cease and desist from violations of the various accounting provisions set forth in the order.

The Commission also filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia alleging that James G. Hanley, Pinnacle's former Vice-President of Operations, circumvented Pinnacle's system of internal accounting controls or caused certain of the companies books and records to be falsified in that he supervised Pinnacle's post-period shipments and inconsistent accounting for sales of certain electronic chips. Hanley settled the action by agreeing, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, to a permanent injunction barring future

violations of certain accounting provisions and to pay a civil money penalty of \$25,000. [SEC v. James G. Hanley, Civil Action No. 1:97CV02307, SS, USDC DC] (LR-15527; AAE Rel. 977) (Rel. 34-39194; AAE Rel. 975; File No. 3-9473)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-97-39) to require that employees of all PHLX member organizations acknowledge notice of PHLX insider trading rules and maintain a current accounts list. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-96-27) submitted by the New York Stock Exchange which sets forth an interpretation of Exchange Rule 409. The amended rule establishes standards regarding the distribution of "summary statements," jointly formulated by member organizations and other financial institutions, and, if applicable, for using "third party agents" to prepare or distribute these customer account statements. Publication of the approval order in the Federal Register is expected during the week of October 6. (Rel. 34-39190)
