INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GOLDMAN SACHS & CO., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 12, 1997, to request a hearing on an application filed by Goldmar. Sachs & Co., et al. Applicants have requested an order pursuant to: Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act requesting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act; Section 6(c) of the Act requesting an exemption from Section 17(e) of the Act and Rule 17e-1

under the Act; and Section 10(f) of the Act requesting an exemption from Section 10(f) and Rule 10f-3 under the Act. The order would permit registered investment companies that have one or more investment advisers, and for which Goldman, Sachs & Co. or an affiliate (Goldman) acts as an investment adviser, to engage in certain principal and brokerage transactions and to purchase securities in certain underwritings. The transactions would be between the investment companies, or the portions of the investment companies' portfolios, that are not advised by Goldman, and Goldman or a member of an underwriting syndicate in which Goldman is a participant. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-97-25) filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> to list options, including full-value and reduced-value LEAPS, on two mutual fund indexes designed by Lipper Analytical Services, Inc. in conjunction with Salomon Brothers Inc. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 20. (Rel. 34-39244)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Cincinnati Stock Exchange</u> (SR-CSE-97-09) to increase net capital requirements for Designated Dealers and non-specialist members. (Rel. 34-39245)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change that has become effective pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-NASD-97-74) relating to SelectNet fees. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 20. (Rel. 34-39248)

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change that has become effective pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-NASD-97-75) relating to the distribution of information concerning the availability of the NASD Regulation, Inc. Public Disclosure Program. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 20. (Rel. 34-39250)

The <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> filed a proposed rule change that has become effective pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-MSRB-97-06) relating to political contributions and prohibitions on municipal securities business, consultants, and recordkeeping. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of

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October 20. (Rel. 34-39251)
