# ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT CHARGES PCO, INC., D/B/A PERSONAL CHOICE OPPORTUNITIES AND DAVID LAING WITH FRAUD

The Commission announced that it filed a complaint on November 13 in federal court in Manhattan charging PCO, Inc., d/b/a Personal Choice Opportunities (PCO), a California-based company, and its former president, David W. Laing (Laing), with fraudulently obtaining approximately \$95 million from investors nationwide by promising them substantial profits through the company's purchases of viatical settlements (Loan Program). Viatical settlements are financial transactions involving the purchase, at a discount, of life insurance policies from terminally ill policy-holders in exchange for the policy-holders' death benefits.

According to the complaint, Laing and PCO falsely represented to investors that they would use investor funds to make investments in viatical settlements. Laing and PCO allegedly promised investors, among other things, that they would receive a 25 percent annual return on their investments in the Loan Program. The complaint alleges that rather than purchasing these policies, Laing and FCO misappropriated and otherwise misused the investors' funds. Moreover, no registration statement was filed, or in effect, with respect to the investments in the Loan Program.

As a result of the foregoing, the Commission alleges that Laing and PCO violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. In the complaint, the Commission seeks final judgments permanently enjoining Laing and PCO from future violations of these provisions, and ordering them to disgorge their ill-gotten gains, plus prejudgment interest. ## INSIDER TRADING CASE AGAINST ROBERT FLANAGAN AND THOMAS FLANAGAN

On November 6, the Commission won summary judgment in its insider trading case against two brothers, Robert and Thomas Flanagan, who had previously been convicted of related criminal charges. The Court permanently enjoined Robert Flanagan from violating the federal securities laws, and ordered him to disgorge \$961,887.66 in profits, pay prejudgment interest, and a civil penalty of \$2,483,189.67. The Court permanently enjoined Thomas Flanagan from violating the federal securities laws, and ordered him to disgorge \$379,524.98 in profits, pay prejudgment interest, and a civil penalty of \$1,138,574.94.

In its summary judgment motion, the Commission demonstrated that in 1990 and 1991, Charles Brumfield, an AT&T labor relations executive, learned about AT&T's secret plans to acquire NCR Corporation, Digital Microwave Corporation, and Teradata Corporation and leaked this information to his colleague, Thomas Alger. Alger tipped Robert Flanagan, who arranged for others (including his brother Thomas) to buy securities in the acquisition targets for him and themselves. Some of the profits were paid to Robert Flanagan, who kicked back a portion to Brumfield and Alger.

The Commission has obtained judgments against or settled with twelve of the defendants in its civil action. Trial against the five remaining defendants is scheduled for June 29, 1998. [SEC v. Charles Brumfield, et al., USDC, SDNY, Civil Action No. 95-9283, JES] (LR-15559)

# CHARLES SMITH FOUND TO BE IN CIVIL CONTEMPT

The Commission announced the entry of an Order finding Charles Smith in Civil Contempt on November 6. Smith and his company, Atlantic Pacific Guarantee Corporation, failed to pay disgorgement of \$126,584, plus prejudgment interest, as required by the Court's July 19, 1996 Final Judgment against them. The Commission alleged that Smith and Atlantic Pacific received \$126,584 in investor funds which had been fraudulently obtained by Kenton Capital, Ltd. and its promoters in connection with prime bank trading programs. The Commission alleged that Kenton and its promoters projected to investors annual returns on these trading programs ranging from 34,200% to over 1,200,000%. Smith and Atlantic Pacific failed to pay any money, and on July 2, 1997, Smith filed bankruptcy individually and on behalf of Atlantic Pacific.

In its opinion, the Court cited numerous examples where Smith was unable to document or account for the transfer of various assets. The Court also noted that Smith submitted false financial statements to the Commission. Thus, the Court held that Smith failed to prove his inability to pay the disgorgement. Within thirty days Smith must identify assets sufficient to pay the Judgment, plus postjudgment interest, and provide a sworn accounting. For further information see the following releases: Lit. Rel.
