FINDINGS MADE AND REMEDIAL SANCTIONS IMPOSED IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST WAYNE CONNERS

The Commission has determined to accept an offer of settlement submitted by Wayne J. Conners in resolution of the administrative proceedings instituted against him on September 30, 1996. Under the terms of the settlement, Conners has consented, without admitting or denying the findings, to an order which bars him from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company; and requires him to pay disgorgement of \$32,198 plus prejudgment interest, but waives payment of the same based upon Conner's demonstrated financial inability to pay.

The Commission's Order finds that, from May 1993 through January 1995, C'est Lestial Waters, Inc. (CWI) raised over \$7 million from more than 100 investors through the offer and sale of unregistered collateral trust bonds (CWI bonds), as well as the securities of certain entities related to CWI. In connection with that offering, CWI, certain of its principals and agents, as well as certain other entities and individual sales representatives, including Conners, violated, variously, the securities registration, antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the federal securities laws. Specifically, these entities and individuals made misrepresentations of material fact and failed to disclose material information to investors regarding investment in the CWI bonds.

From June 1993 through January 1995, Conners offered and sold more than \$368,000 in CWI bonds. In connection with his sales of the CWI bonds, Conners made untrue statements of material facts to investors, including the following: that the CWI bonds were fully secured through a first and irrevocable lien interest in certain assets of CWI in favor of investors; that the CWI bonds were fully insured to guarantee safety; and that CWI was an old company which had been issuing the CWI bonds for years.

In addition, from January 1994 through June 1994, Conners offered and sold approximately \$450,000 of the securities of entities related to CWI (CWI entities). In connection with his sales of the securities of the CWI entities, Conners made untrue statements of material facts to investors, including the following: that the CWI entities were established and ongoing businesses; and that the securities of the CWI entities were fully secured through a first and irrevocable lien interest in certain assets of those entities in favor of investors. Based on this conduct, Conners willfully violated Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

Conners received over \$105,000 in commissions from his sales of the CWI bonds and the securities of the CWI entities. Only \$32,198 of these commissions are subject to disgorgement in this proceeding, as the remaining amount of commissions Conners received were sought by the Commission in a related civil proceeding in the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania (SEC v. C'est Lestial Waters, Inc., Civil Action No. 95-642). On August 27, 1997 a Final Judgment and Order was entered against Conners in that civil action, enjoining Conners from future violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Conners consented to the Final Judgment and Order, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. (Rel. 34-39335; File No. 3-9125)

FORMER OFFICER ORDERED TO DISGORGE \$400,000 IN INSIDER TRADING CASE

The Commission announced that on October 28, 1997, the Honorable Frederick J. Scullin, Jr. of the United States District Court for the Northern District of New York entered a Final Judgment against John S. Nadolski, the former president of Marietta Corporation, headquartered in Cortland, New York. The Final Judgment enjoins Nadolski from violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws; bars him from serving as an officer or director of

any public company for a period of five years; and requires him to pay disgorgement of \$300,000 and prejudgment interest of \$100,000. Under the terms of settlement, Nadolski would pay \$300,000 upon entry of the Final Judgment and be required to pay the remaining \$100,000 through the sale of assets. Nadolski consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

The Commission originally filed this action on August 18, 1995, alleging that between 1989 and 1991 Nadolski engaged in a fraudulent scheme to misrepresent Marietta's financial condition by causing false accounting entries to be made in its financial books and records, overstating sales and understating expenses. These changes dramatically increased the net income Marietta reported in public filings with the Commission.

The complaint further alleged that in November 1989, Nadolski sold 100,000 shares of Marietta stock for \$1.92 million while in possession of inside information that Marietta's financial condition had been falsely reported to the public. FORMER SALESPERSON IN PONZI SCHEME ORDERED TO DISGORGE \$519,000

The Commission announced that on October 29, 1997, the Honorable Garrett E. Brown of the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey entered a Final Judgment and Order against defendant Cindy J. Myers. The Final Judgment ordered Myers to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$519,000, plus prejudgment interest thereon, but waived payment of the same based upon a sworn financial statement demonstrating Myers' inability to pay. Myers consented to this relief, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. In September 1996, Judge Brown had entered a permanent injunction against Myers, pursuant to her consent, enjoining her from violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws.

On September 14, 1996, the staff filed this action against Myers, Charles N. Cugliari, and three other defendants. The Commission alleged that Cugliari, with the assistance of Myers and others, conducted a Ponzi scheme involving the fraudulent sale of approximately \$70 million of unregistered CNC investments to over 2,000 public investors. Myers was the second most active seller of CNC investments. In 1994 alone, Myers received approximately \$300,000 in commissions.

The Commission further charged that Myers and others made numerous material misrepresentations and omissions in connection with the sale of CNC investments to public investors. Among other things, Myers misrepresented or omitted to disclose the true nature of the CNC investment and the financial condition of CNC, and the sales commission arrangement CNC had with various salespersons. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INTEGRITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act to Integrity Life Insurance Company, Integrity Life Insurance Company Separate Account II, National Integrity Life Insurance Company and National Integrity Life Insurance Company Separate Account II (collectively, Applicants) approving the substitution of shares of certain registered management investment companies (Current Portfolios) with shares of other registered management investment companies (Substitute Portfolios). An order also has been issued pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Section 17(a) to permit Applicants to carry out the substitutions by redeeming shares of the Current Portfolios in-kind, and using the redemption proceeds to purchase shares of the Substitute Portfolios, and to permit Applicants to combine certain subaccounts holding shares of the same Substitute Portfolio after the substitution. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-97-78) amending the Interpretation on the Release of Disciplinary Information, IM-8310-2 of Rule 8310 of the Procedural Rules of the NASD, to include additional information required to be reported pursuant to the revised Forms U-4, U-5, and BD. Interim pages for Forms U-4 and U-5 also have been filed to facilitate the immediate release of this additional information. Publication of the notice of the proposed rule change in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of November 17. (Rel. 34-39322)

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-97-52) to amend PHLX Rule 1047, "Trading Rotations, Halts, and Suspensions," to, among other things, require reverse rotations when there is a heavy influx of orders and to require floor official approval of second and subsequent rotations. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 24. (Rel. 34-39332)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission is publishing notice of a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Pacific Exchange</u> that has become effective pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-PCX-97-44). The proposed rule change relates to applicant specialists on the Exchange. Publication of the notice in the <u>Federal Register</u>

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> (SR-CBOE-97-56) relating to the elimination of the prohibition on the use of headsets and other telephone technology. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 17. (Rel. 34-39331)
