ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

JUDGMENTS ENTERED AGAINST JOSEPH BREMONT, JIMMY SANCHEZ, MICHAEL SPECTOR, LOOMIS LTD., AND R.P.S. FINANCIAL GROUP, INC. FOR OBTAINING OVER \$2.1 MILLION THROUGH FRAUDULENT "PRIME BANK" SECURITIES SCHEME

The Commission announced that on November 26, 1997, the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York entered Final Consent Judgments of Permanent Injunction and other Relief against Joseph A. Bremont (Bremont), a 58 year old resident of Ocala, Florida, and Jimmy B. Sanchez (Sanchez), a resident of Texas. The Final Judgments order Bremont to disgorge \$1,061,520.00 plus prejudgment interest of \$244,417.21 and order Sanchez to disgorge \$594,000.00 plus prejudgment interest of \$166,073.22. The Final Judgments also enjoin Bremont and Sanchez from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Bremont and Sanchez neither admitted nor denied the allegations in the Commission's complaint, filed on November 21, 1996.

The Commission also announced that on October 30, 1997, the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York entered a Final Judgment by Default against relief defendant Loomis Ltd. (Loomis), a company based in Nassau, Bahamas. Under the judgment, the court ordered Loomis to pay disgorgement of \$669,000.00 plus prejudgment interest of \$205,516.51. In addition, on October 15, 1997, the court entered Final Consent Judgments against relief defendants Michael R. Spector (Spector), a New Hampshire accountant, Financial Group, Inc. (R.P.S.), a New Hampshire and R.P.S. Under the judgments, the court ordered Spector to corporation. disgorge \$119,480.00 plus prejudgment of \$36,871.28, and ordered R.P.S. to pay, jointly and severally with Spector, disgorgement of \$117,980.00 plus prejudgment interest of \$36,743.68. R.P.S. and Spector neither admitted nor denied the allegations in Commission's complaint. The payment of disgorgement and prejudgment interest by Spector and R.P.S. have been waived based on their demonstrated inability to pay.

The Commission's complaint alleged that Bremont, Sanchez, and two

entities controlled by Bremont, Commercial Capital Resources, Inc., a Florida corporation, and Comcar International, Ltd., a Bahamian company, fraudulently obtained more than \$2.1 million since 1993 by engaging in a scheme involving fictitious "prime bank" securities. According to the complaint, the defrauded investors included residents of New York, Indiana, and a group of cadets at the United States Military Academy at West Point. The Commission's complaint also alleged that investor funds were paid to Loomis, Spector and R.P.S. [SEC v. Joseph A. Bremont, Jimmy B. Sanchez, Comcar International, Ltd., Commercial Capital Resources, Inc., Loomis Ltd., Michael R. Spector, and R.P.S. Financial Group, Inc., 96 Civ. 8771, LAK, SDNY] (LR-15579)

STEVEN JAKUBOWSKI ENJOINED AND ORDERED TO PAY DISGORGEMENT AND CIVIL PENALTIES

The Commission announced that on September 30, 1997, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois entered Final Judgment against Steven R. Jakubowski (Jakubowski), a resident of LaGrange, Illinois, enjoining him from violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, ordering him to pay \$78,423.23 in disgorgement and prejudgment interest, and \$51,500.74 in civil penalties.

The Court entered Judgment after granting the Commission's motion for summary judgment, and finding that in 1991 and 1992, Jakubowski engaged in securities fraud by misrepresenting facts to four savings and loan institutions in connection with the purchase of stock in those institutions. Specifically, Jakubowski located several savings and loan accountholders who held non-transferable rights to buy newly-issued stock in the savings and loan institutions, which were converting from mutual to stock ownership. He then arranged to obtain the stock to which the accountholders were entitled for himself, for Generation Capital Associates (GCA), an unregistered investment company, and for GCA's president, Frank Hart. Jakubowski circumvented the prohibition on transferability by causing the accountholders to misrepresent to the savings and loans that they were purchasing the stock for themselves.

GCA and Hart were previously enjoined, by consent, on July 13, 1994. [SEC v. Steven R. Jakubowski, C.A. No. 94C4539, N.D.Ill.] (LR-15580)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONWIDE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by Nationwide Life Insurance Company, Nationwide Advisory Services, Inc., Nationwide Asset Allocation Trust, Nationwide Investing Foundation, Nationwide Investing Foundation II, and Nationwide Separate Account Trust.

Applicants request an order pursuant to Sections 6(c), 17(b), and 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act exempting them from Sections 12(d)(1)(A), 12(d)(1)(B), and 17(a) of the Act to commence operations as a "fund of funds" whereby certain investment companies would invest in both investment companies that are part of the same "group of investment companies" and investment companies that are not part of the same "group of investment companies." Other investments of the "fund of funds" could include government securities, short-term fixed income securities, and a guaranteed investment contract. (Rel. IC-22924 - December 3)

TMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-97-8) publishing an interpretation concerning Rule G-38 on consultants. The proposed rule change became effective immediately. Publication of the notice in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of December 8. (Rel. 34-39391)

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Cincinnati Stock Exchange</u> related to transaction credits (SR-CSE-97-12) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 8. (Rel. 34-39395)

The <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-97-31) to amend its Rule 500 to revise the procedures a NYSE-listed company must follow to delist its securities from the NYSE.
