ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF FREDERICK ENTMAN, NORMAN ROTHSTEIN, FRANK PALUMBO, JACOB WONSOVER, HOWARD PERLES, M. RIMSON & CO., INC. AND MOSHE RIMSON

The Commission announced the settlement of administrative proceedings, instituted on December 28, 1994 pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 15(b)(4), 15(b)(6), and 19(h)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against Frank Louis Palumbo, a former registered representative and national sales director of J.W. Gant & Associates, Inc. The proceedings were based on allegations that in March, April, and August, 1989 Palumbo willfully violated and caused violations of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act by facilitating sales of 300,000 shares of unregistered common stock of Gil-Med Industries, Inc. The Commission ordered Palumbo to cease and desist permanently from violating or causing violations and future violations of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act, and suspended Palumbo from associating with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser for a period of three months from entry of the Commission's order. SANJAY SAXENA BARRED

The Commission announced today the institution of proceedings pursuant to Sections 203(e) and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Sanjay Saxena (Saxena), a registered investment adviser, individually and d/b/a The Phoenix Group, d/b/a Vital Information, and d/b/a Infinity Investments Partnership. Saxena consented to the simultaneous entry of an order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. The Commission's order was based on the entry by consent of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Saxena, in which he neither admitted nor denied the Commission's allegations, and was ordered to pay disgorgement of \$703,000, and prejudgment and postjudgment interest totalling \$71,793.04.

The Commission's complaint alleged that Saxena made a fraudulent public offering of at least \$3.2 million of unregistered securities, fraudulently projected rates of return in excess of 50% annually, falsely stated that he would repay one-quarter of any investor losses, falsely stated that the investment was profitable, and diverted at least \$656,000 invested by 45 investors to repay other investors. SEC v. BORLINGHAUS, ET AL.

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint in the Southern District of New York against Michael Borlinghaus, Joseph Latona, Leonard Bellezza, Jeffrey F. Green, Joseph P. Greenwald, and Heinz Grein, charging them with insider trading in the securities of Motel 6, L.P., and Norton Co.

The Commission alleges that in 1990 Greenwald received material, nonpublic information concerning a planned tender offer for Motel 6 that originated with a Motel 6 executive. Greenwald thereafter tipped Green and Latona. Latona tipped Borlinghaus, who tipped Grein, who tipped Bellezza. Each defendant purchased Motel 6 stock and/or options.

The Commission also alleges that in 1990 Bellezza received information concerning a planned tender offer for Norton from a friend whose original source was a paralegal at a law firm representing the intended acquiror's financial advisor. Bellezza tipped Borlinghaus and Grein and arranged with them to purchase Norton securities in offshore accounts. Grein tipped Latona, who tipped Greenwald, who tipped Green, all of whom purchased Norton securities.

The Commission seeks injunctive relief, disgorgement, prejudgment interest and penalties. [SEC v. Borlinghaus, et al., 95 Civ. 1520, SDNY] (LR-14429)

FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST PNF INDUSTRIES, INC.

The Commission announced that on February 23 the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief against PNF Industries, Inc. PNF consented to the entry of the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint filed September 27, 1994. The Final Judgment enjoins PNF from violations of the antifraud, books and records and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. The Final Judgment orders PNF to, within 60 days of entry of the Final Judgment, file its Annual Report on Form 10-KSB for its fiscal year ended August 31, 1993, and to amend or file certain other reports with the Commission.

In its complaint, the Commission alleged that, among other things, in connection with PNF's 1992 bid to be listed on the Emerging Company Marketplace of the American Stock Exchange, PNF materially overstated its assets and materially inflated its stockholders equity from a deficit of \$255,361 to a surplus of \$16,125,963; made false and misleading disclosures about PNF's licensing agreements and proposed licensing agreements; improperly recorded expenses and a consulting fee; and failed to disclose lack of auditor independence. [SEC v. PNF Industries, Inc., Alfred Avasso, Otis Hastings, Samuel Gottfried, James Neville, Alphonso Margino, Jeffrey Pearlman and Louis Fox, Civ. No. 94-4691-JCL, D.N.J.] (LR-14430; AAE Rel. 652)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FRANK RUSSELL INVESTMENT COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Frank Russell Investment Company, et al. under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for a conditional exemption from Sections 18(f), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Act. The order would permit applicants to offer an unlimited number of classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities. (Rel. IC-20939 - March 6)

NORWEST FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 31 to request a hearing on an application filed by Norwest Funds, et al. for an order under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from Section 17(a), and under Rule 17d-1 to permit certain transactions in accordance with Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1. The order would permit certain money market funds to sell their shares to affiliated funds. (Rel. IC-20940 - March 6)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Electric System, a registered holding company, New England Energy, Incorporated (NEEI), a wholly owned subsidiary company of NEES, and New England Power Company, also a wholly owned subsidiary company of NEES, for NEEI to refinance its present bank debt through an agreement for loans of up to \$225 million with a syndicate of banks. (Rel. 35-26243)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, to issue and sell, from time to time through December 31, 2000, up to 2,000,000 shares of its authorized but unissued common stock, \$1.00 par value, to the agent for participants in National's Dividend Reinvestment and Stock Purchase Plan. National proposes to use the proceeds from the sale of the common stock to repay existing short-term and long-term debt, to pay interest and dividends, to make additional capital contributions to its wholly owned subsidiaries and for other corporate purposes. THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, to amend its certificate of incorporation to change the description of preferred stock, as presently authorized, in order to permit the use of preferred stock pursuant to a proposed shareholder rights plan. The Commission has authorized the solicitation of proxies. (Rel. 35-26244)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>National</u> <u>Securities Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-NSCC-95-02) implementing a one day settling capability. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 6. (Rel. 34-35442) 1

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-95-06) to amend Articles V and VIII of its Constitution to allow the PSE to approve business trusts, limited liability companies and other organizational structures as member organizations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 6. (Rel. 34-35443)
