ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST MARK GROSHANS, LEONARD GROSHANS AND DOLORES GROSHANS SETTLED

The Commission announced the settlement of administrative proceedings, previously instituted on August 24, 1994, against Mark W. Groshans, Leonard A. Groshans and Dolores A. Groshans. The proceedings were based on misconduct involving SFT, Inc. (SFT), a now-defunct mutual fund formerly located in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania. The Commission accepted the respondents' Offers consenting to the entry of an Order, without admitting or denying the findings therein.

The Order finds that Leonard and Mark Groshans violated the antifraud provisions by assisting a fraudulent scheme wherein Wesley Groshans, SFT's former president and their father, sold shares in a private company he controlled to SFT for \$2,016,000. In addition, the Order finds that these respondents artificially inflated the closing share prices of various stocks held in the portfolio of one of SFT's series funds. The Order also finds that Dolores and Mark Groshans aided and abetted violations of the antifraud provisions by making a false entry in SFT's shareholder records indicating that one of its affiliates owned SFT fund securities, which were then used to satisfy an outstanding bank loan.

The Order bars each of the respondents from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. (Rels IA-1478; 34-35486; IC-20953)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST LOUIS ACEVEDO

The Commission today announced the institution of administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 203(e) and (f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act) against Louis A. Acevedo (Acevedo).

The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that on October 31, 1994, Acevedo consented to the entry of the Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief (Final Judgment), and on November 1, 1994, the United States District Court for the Southern District of California entered the Final Judgment. The Final Judgment restrains and enjoins Acevedo from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and certain provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. Additionally, Acevedo was ordered to disgorge \$243,000. In its complaint, the Commission alleged, among other things, that Acevedo engaged in a scheme to misappropriate and misuse certain "soft dollar" funds intended for the benefit of Acevedo's investment advisory clients.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Acevedo are true and, if so, what remedial sanctions, if any, are appropriate. (Rel. IA-1479)
