COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN LEVITT DETAILS PLANS TO MAKE DATABASE WIDELY AVAILABLE

In a speech on August 27 in Nashville, Tennessee, SEC Chairman Arthur Levitt announced the agency's plans to make its electronic database of corporate information widely available to the public through the Internet. (Press Rel. 95-175)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION IMPOSES SANCTIONS AGAINST DANIEL BAXLEY

The Commission instituted proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Daniel C. Baxley (Baxley), a former registered representative with First Alliance Securities, Inc. (First Alliance), a now defunct penny stock broker-dealer headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia. The Commission simultaneously accepted Baxley's Offer of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, except for findings that on July 24, 1995, he was permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws in SEC v. Daniel C. Baxley, Civil Action No. 1:95-CV-1761-JEC, N.D. Ga., and that on October 11, 1994, he pled guilty to one count of conspiracy, eight counts of securities fraud, and two counts of interstate transportation of monies taken by fraud, Baxley consented to be barred from associating with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company, and from participating in any offering of penny stock.

The Commission's complaint alleged, among other things, that Baxley, as a registered representative and, from time to time, a manager with First Alliance made, and caused others to make, numerous misrepresentations to customers and unauthorized trades in customer accounts. The complaint further alleged that Baxley omitted, and caused others to omit, to tell customers that First Alliance insiders had undisclosed interests in stocks promoted by the firm and that First Alliance policy prohibited net selling, preventing customers from withdrawing funds from

the firm. (Rel. 34-36152)

IN THE MATTER OF RICHARD ALLERTON, JR. AND JOSEPH COTE

The Commission announced today the issuance of an Order relating to proceedings previously instituted against Richard Allerton, Jr. and Joseph G. Coté, both former employees of Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Inc. (Merrill).

The proceedings concerned Allerton's and Coté's role in a series of related sale and repurchase transactions between Merrill and a customer, Guarantee Security Life Insurance Company (GSL), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Transmark USA, Inc. Allerton's and Coté's conduct resulted in violations by Merrill of the recordkeeping provisions of the Exchange Act.

The proceedings also involved an unrelated series of corporate bond repurchase agreements between Merrill and one of Allerton's other customers which also resulted in violations by Merrill of the same recordkeeping provisions.

Pursuant to the Order, among other things, Allerton was suspended from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company for one year. Coté was ordered to cease and desist from violations of the recordkeeping provisions of the Exchange Act. (Rel. 34-36155)

FOURTH FORMER FIRST ALLIANCE BROKER ENJOINED

The Securities and Exchange Commission announced that on July 24, 1995, in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, a Final Judgement was entered against Daniel C. Baxley (Baxley), permanently enjoining him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Baxley was formerly associated with First Alliance Securities, Inc. (First Alliance), a now defunct penny stock boiler room selling to unsophisticated investors through high pressure sales tactics, misrepresentations and omissions. The complaint alleged that Baxley, whose responsibilities included supervising other First Alliance stockbrokers, made and caused others to make material misrepresentations, including misrepresenting to customers the value of the securities which he sold and the success of the underlying companies. The complaint also alleged that Baxley omitted to disclose the firm policy prohibiting net-selling and material facts regarding the prevailing market price of First Alliance stocks, including the fact that the prices contained excessive markups and were arbitrarily set by firm principals. The complaint further alleged that Baxley engaged in frequent unauthorized trading in the accounts of two of his customers. [S.E.C. v. Daniel C. Baxley, 1:95-CV-1761-JEC, N.D. Ga.] (LR-14617)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS CO., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company (Consolidated), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary, Consolidated System LNG Company (Consolidated LNG), for Consolidated LNG to buy back shares of its common stock from Consolidated to effect a return of capital to the parent. (Rel. 35-26360)

CINERGY CORP., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing CINergy Corp., a registered holding company, to issue guarantees and to provide letters of credit in connection with short-term borrowings of certain of its subsidiaries, and authorizing certain of CINergy's subsidiaries: (1) to issue notes in connection with short-term borrowings; (2) to issue commercial paper; and (3) to implement a money pool arrangement to provide for their short-term cash requirements, in each case through May 31, 1997. Jurisdiction was reserved over a request for an order of the Commission declaring that U.S. Energy Partners is not a "subsidiary company" of CINergy Corp. within the meaning of Section 2(a)(8) of the Act. U.S. Energy Partners is a gas marketing partnership in which CG&E Resource Marketing, Inc., a subsidiary of CINergy Corp. owns a one-third general partnership interest. (Rel. 35-26362)

SELF REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Pursuant to Rule 19b-4 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> on August 21 filed with the Commission a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-95-18) to increase the position limits on the PSE Technology Index to 37,500 contracts on the same side of the market. In addition, PSE proposes to change the terms of the option contracts on the Index from p.m. settlement a.m. settlement. Publication of the notice is expected to appear in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 28. (Rel. 34-36146)

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-95-10) under Section 19(b) of the Securities Exchange Act which allow OCC to replace its present preliminary and final processing cycles for Saturday expiration options with a single real-time processing procedure. Publication in the Federal Register during the week of August 28. (Rel. 34-36149)

The <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-95-13) amending three of its rules relating to fees assessed to broker, dealers and municipal securities dealers. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 28. (Rel. 34-36150)
