# COMPLAINT FILED IN PRIME BANK CASE

The Commission filed a complaint on August 24, 1995 in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina seeking preliminary and permanent injunctions and other equitable relief against Jerome E. Pinckney of Wilmington, North Carolina, Richard L. Arnold of Raleigh, North Carolina, Donald E. Elder of Hilton Head, South Carolina, Fernando Cruz of Linden, New Jersey, Shaun K.R. Maxwell of Auburn, Washington, Anthony Bukovich, Jr. of Tampa, Florida, and Six Capital Corporation, a Florida corporation, for violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The complaint alleges that the defendants defrauded investors by making numerous misrepresentations and omissions of material fact in connection with the offer of two investment contracts based on the purchase and sale of so-called "prime bank securities." The first offer promised a 9% weekly return, guaranteed by a top U.S. bank or trust, and required a \$10 million minimum investment which would remain 100% safe in the investors' bank account. Several defendants offered a second prime bank investment requiring an \$870,000 minimum investment, purportedly to be used to purchase and sell discounted guarantees issued by the top fifteen banks in western Europe. The second offer, which was interrupted by the staff's investigation, promised that a major U.S. brokerage firm would repurchase the bank guarantees after a mark up. Investors were asked to execute a Limited Power of Attorney providing access to their funds in both schemes. [SEC v. Jerome E. Pinckney, Richard L. Arnold, Donald E. Elder, Fernando Cruz, Shaun K.R. # SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

# IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>International Securities Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-ISCC-95-04), which became effective upon filing, relating to adding an additional service provider to the Global Clearance Network Service. Publication of the proposed rule change is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 9. (Rel. 34-36339)

The MBS Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-MBSCC-95-06), which became effective upon filing, to modify the Original Notification Message Processing Fees for the Electronic Pool Notification Service. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 9. (Rel. 34-36340)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change and issued notice of filing and granted accelerated approval to Amendment No. 1 to proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Phlx-95-51) to increase the requirements placed on the securities trading accounts of employees of member and participant organizations.
