COMMISSION AND OUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN LEVITT AND TREASURY SECRETARY RUBIN ANNOUNCE JOINT EFFORT TO WORK WITH LOCAL FINANCE OFFICERS

On October 16, Chairman Levitt and Treasury Secretary Robert Rubin announced that the SEC and the Department of the Treasury will undertake a cooperative effort to work with state and local finance officials to emphasize the importance of prudent management of public funds. (Press Rel. 221)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST PRISON INMATE AND FORMER PRISON OFFICER IN SCHEME TO DEFRAUD BROKER-DEALER

The Commission announced that on October 16 it filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York against Ronald C. Black (Black), Russell W. Brown (Brown) and May B. Owens (Owens), charging Black and Brown with violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and naming Owens as a relief defendant.

The complaint alleges that, in July 1993, Brown provided Black with a cellular telephone, and the names and telephone numbers of various brokerage firms, including Nomura. Black, while in prison, used the cellular telephone to call Nomura's New York City offices, open a securities account under a fictitious corporate name, and place orders to purchase securities as part of a scheme with Brown to defraud Nomura. In furtherance of this scheme to defraud, Black made material misrepresentations to Nomura about his ability to pay for these securities. Black, Brown or someone working in concert with them, also telephoned Nomura, posed as an official from Nomura's bank and claimed falsely that Black had transferred funds to Nomura's account

for the benefit of Black. Black then instructed Nomura to wire a portion of those funds to Brown and Owens. After Nomura initiated the wire transfers, Nomura learned that its bank had not received any funds from Black. Although Nomura was able to stop the transfer to Brown before Brown received the money, Owens received the money transferred to her.

In its complaint, the Commission seeks permanent injunctions, disgorgement plus prejudgment interest, civil penalties, and other equitable relief. [SEC v. Ronald C. Black, Russell W. Brown and May B. Owens, 95 Civ. 8766, MP, SDNY] (LR-14691)

COMMISSION SEEKS CIVIL CONTEMPT IN PRIME BANK NOTE SCHEME

The Commission announced that on September 29 it filed a Motion for an Order to Show Cause why defendants David E. Wallace and Earl J. Latiolais should not be held in civil contempt. The motion was filed in Securities and Exchange Commission v. Jedi Group, Ltd, Jedi Holding Co., David E. Wallace, and Earl J. Latiolais, in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas.

Wallace and Latiolais were the principals in a scheme involving the fraudulent sale of investments in non-existent prime bank notes. The scheme raised more than \$3.4 million from investors before the Commission obtained a temporary restraining order halting the illegal conduct and freezing the assets. Wallace and Latiolais later agreed to a permanent injunction and to liability for \$777,725.34 of ill-gotten gains and \$110,682.67 prejudgment interest. The district court's final order allowed them to satisfy the debt if they paid a total of \$250,000 in four installments. However, Wallace and Latiolais have failed to pay two installments when due.

Hearing on the motion is set for November 16, 1995 in Houston, Texas, before Judge Ewing Werlein, Jr. [SEC v. Jedi Group, Ltd, Jedi Holding Co., David E. Wallace and Earl J. Latiolais, USDC, SD TX, No. H-92-934] (LR-14692)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT CO.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Central Power and Light Co. (CP&L), a wholly owned electric subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to incur obligations in connection with the issuance by Nueces County Navigation District and/or Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority, in one or more series, of up to \$95 million in Pollution Control Revenue Bonds (New Bonds). CP&L also proposes to limit its interest rate risk or lower its interest rate costs on variable rate New Bonds through the use of caps and collars. (Rel. 35-26390)

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 6 to request a hearing on a proposal by General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU) to issue and sell, from time to time, up to 250,000 shares of authorized but unissued or previously reacquired shares of GPU common stock to participants under GPU's employee saving plans. (Rel. 35-26391)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule chant (SR-Amex-95-35) to amend Amex Rule 900(a), "Applicability," to confirm the Exchange's enforcement authority over Amex members' options transactions effected on another options exchange; and Amex Rules 904, "Position Limits," and 905, "Exercise Limits," to clarify the Exchange's enforcement authority with respect to the enforcement of the Amex's position and exercise limit rules. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 16. (Rel. 34-36353)
