### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, its wholly owned gas public utility subsidiary company, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, and certain of NFG's wholly owned nonutility subsidiary

companies, to enter into one or more interest rate swap agreements in connection with long-term debt, not to exceed in the aggregate \$350 million in notional amounts, and related derivative instruments such as interest rate caps, floors and collars, from time to time through December 31, 1997. (Rel. 35-26393)

## NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to 1,390,844 shares of its common stock, from time to time through October 31, 2000, to its Customer Stock Purchase Plan. (Rel. 35-26394)

## NORTHEAST UTILITIES SERVICE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 13 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities Service Company, North Atlantic Energy Service Corporation, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, Yankee Atomic Electric Company, and Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company, subsidiaries of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, to enter into a Reciprocal Support Agreement. Under this agreement, North Atlantic, Northeast Nuclear, Yankee Atomic, and Connecticut Yankee may temporarily share employees, equipment and other resources, and NUSCO would provide billing, accounting and other similar services to facilitate the transactions among these companies. #### CINERGY CORPORATION

Transok also requests authorization to transfer certain natural gas compression assets, as a capital contribution, from Transok to Transok Gas Processing Company, another of its wholly-owned subsidiaries. ## APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has noticed an amendment to and granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> (SR-CBOE-95-39) relating to the listing of regular and long-term index options on the Germany 25 Index, and long-term options on a reduced-value Germany 25 Index. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 23. (Rel. 34-36390; International Series Rel. 872)

#### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-95-58) to require certain persons who solicit or handle business in securities and are compensated by a member or participant organization for which the Phlx is the Designated Examining Authority to register with the Phlx by filing Form U-4 and to clarify that the Series 7A is the appropriate examination for Phlx Limited Registration/Floor Members. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 23. (Rel. 34-36395)

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-95-48) that would allow the NASD to revise the subscriber deposit requirements, which would pertain only to new subscribers or existing subscribers that have defaulted on the payment of their charges. The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed with the a notice of filing and immediate effectiveness of a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-95-47) that would allow the NASD to revise the subscriber deposit requirements, which would pertain only to new subscribers or existing subscribers that have defaulted on the payment of their charges.
