#### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST JAMES PEARCE

The Commission announced that a Permanent Injunction and Other Relief was obtained against James A. Pearce (Pearce) on December 11. The Commission filed its complaint against Pearce on September 5 alleging that Pearce participated in a fraudulent scheme with Steven D. Wymer (Wymer) and the investment advisers controlled by Wymer, Denman & Co. and Institutional Treasury Management, Inc. (collectively, ITM).

Without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the complaint, Pearce consented to the entry of a Judgment permanently enjoining him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act, the Exchange Act and the Advisers Act, Section 207 of the Advisers Act and Rule 206(4)-1(a)(5), orders him to disgorge \$604,096 plus prejudgment interest but waives payment based on his demonstrated financial inability to pay. The judgment against Pearce notes the appropriateness of civil penalties but does not impose them based upon his demonstrated inability to pay. [SEC v. James A.
