ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION BARS STEEN RONLOV

The Commission instituted a public administrative proceeding against Steen Ronlov (Ronlov) pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act. Simultaneous with the institution of the proceedings, Ronlov submitted an Offer of Settlement in which, while neither admitting nor denving the Commission's findings, he consented to the entry of an Order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. The Order was based on a permanent injunction against Ronlov action arising from the Commission's investigation concerning the activities of convicted felon and security violator, Steven D. Wymer (Wymer), and the investment advisers controlled by Wymer Denman & Co. and Institutional Treasury Management, Inc. (collectively, ITM). The Commission's complaint alleges that Ronlov, while acting as an ITM salesman, solicited potential advisory clients knowing that Wymer would misappropriate their funds and thereafter concealed Wymer's misappropriation of five clients' investments by reporting fabricated profitable trades to the clients. Furthermore, Ronlov directly misappropriated \$250,000 from a prospective ITM client and also participated in Wymer's nominee option trading, profiting an additional \$1,373,973. In total, Ronlov received \$1,681,283 in ill-gotten gains. (Rel. IA-1544)

ORDER PURSUANT TO RULE 102(E) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES OF PRACTICE ISSUED AGAINST STUART COOPER

The Commission announced today the issuance of an Order Instituting Proceedings and Opinion and Order Pursuant to Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Stuart D. Cooper (Cooper) of Miami, Florida. Cooper consented to the entry of the Order and to a suspension from practicing before the Commission with the right to apply for readmission after two years, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings. The Order found that Cooper had engaged in improper professional conduct within the meaning of Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice.

The Order makes findings that Cooper, a sole practitioner CPA, failed to conduct his audit of the 1990 financial statements of Met Capital

Corporation, a reporting company, in accordance with Generally Accepted Auditing Standards and that Met's financial statements were not presented in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles. Cooper failed to obtain sufficient competent evidential material to support the valuation assigned to property acquired from related parties under common control, failed to make the required related party transaction disclosure, and failed to present certain interests on a consolidated basis. CIVIL ACTION AGAINST JOSEPH EVANS, ET AL.

On December 27 the Commission filed a complaint against four defendants alleging that they committed insider trading by purchasing the securities of Alias Research, Inc. and/or Wavefront Technologies, Inc.

The Commission's suit, filed in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, alleges that the defendants violated Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Simultaneously with the commencement of the action, the defendants consented, without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, to the entry of final judgments permanently enjoining them from violating Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5. Evans agreed to pay a \$20,000 civil penalty. David Evans agreed to pay \$29,211.84, representing disgorgement of \$14,100 and prejudgment interest of \$1011.84 and a civil penalty of \$14,100. Breakman agreed to pay \$25,140.23, representing disgorgement of \$633.75. agreed to pay \$49,363.86, representing disgorgement of \$23,827 and prejudgment interest of \$1,709.86 and a civil penalty of \$23,827. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GREAT-WEST LIFE & ANNUITY INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 22, 1996 to request a hearing on an application filed by Great-West Life & Annuity Company (GWL&A), Maxim Series Account (the Separate Account) and The Great-West Life Assurance Company. The application requests an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit GWL&A to deduct a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Separate Account in connection with the offer and sale of certain flexible premium variable annuity contracts issued with a guaranteed death benefit (the Contracts) and any contracts (Future Contracts) offered in the future by the Account which are substantially similar in all material respects to the Contracts; and the assets of separate

accounts established in the future by GWL&A, which are substantially similar to the Separate Account, in connection with the offer and sale of Contracts and Future Contracts. (Rel. IC-21626 - December 27)

SMITH BREEDEN INSTITUTIONAL SHORT DURATION U.S. GOVERNMENT FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Smith Breeden Institutional Short Duration U.S. Government Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-21627 - December 27)

NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting National Life Insurance Company (the Company), National Variable Life Insurance Account, and Equity Securities, Inc. (collectively, Applicants) from Section 27(c)(2) of the Act and Rule 6e-3(T)(c)(4)(v) thereunder to the extent necessary to permit Applicants and other separate accounts that the Company may establish in the future to support flexible premium variable life insurance contracts, to deduct from premium payments received an amount that is reasonable in relation to the Company's increased federal tax burden resulting from the application of Section 848 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Participants Trust Company filed notice of a proposed rule change

(SR-PTC-95-08) under Securities Exchange Act Rule 19b-4 establishing the change of the opening of processing activity for security transactions on a permanent basis. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 25. (Rel. 34-36624)

The Commission received a proposed rule change filing (SR-Phlx-95-74) by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> on September 25, 1995 that would list and trade options on the Phlx Big Three Auto Sector Index, a capitalization weighted index developed by the Phlx composed of all of the U.S. automobile manufacturing company stocks. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 25. (Rel. 34-36637)

On December 16 the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-95-59) to amend Section 65 of the Uniform Practice Code to require members who are participants in a registered clearing agency to use the electronic facilities of such agency to transmit customer account transfer instructions. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 2, 1996. (Rel. 34-36638)

Pursuant to Rule 19b-4 under the Securities Exchange Act, the American Stock Exchange filed with the Commission on December 11 a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-95-50) to approve for listing and trading under Section 107 of the Amex Company Guide commodity indexed preferred or debt securities. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> to charge a fee for terminal equipment (SR-NYSE-95-40) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 25. (Rel. 34-36630)

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Cincinnati Stock Exchange</u> to impose a transaction fee on members acting as agents for public agency limit orders executed from the limit order book and to lower fees charged Designated Dealers (SR-CSE-95-08) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 25. (Rel. 34-36631)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-95-30) under Rule 19b-4 to prohibit NASD members from executing overthe-counter transactions in an exchange-listed security that is the subject of an initial public offering until the security has opened for trading on the exchange that lists the security. (Rel. 34-36612)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Pursuant to Rule 19b-4 under the Securities Exchange Act, the Commission has approved a proposal (SR-Phlx-95-62) by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> which amends the Phlx's Selective Quoting Facility (SQF) for foreign currency options. The SQF, as amended, will categorize series which maintain open interest but have not traded within the previous five days as non-update series; and amend the definition of update series to include the approximately 10, 20, 30, 40, and 50 delta strikes below and above the underlying price rather than the four strike prices above and below the underlying price. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 25. (Rel. 34-36636)

The Commission granted approval of a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-95-14) filed by the <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act. The rule change modifies the MSRB's rules concerning the settlement dates for "when, as and if issued" transactions, the confirmation of inter-dealer transactions, and providing new issue information to registered securities clearing agencies.
