#### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

#### ADOPTION OF UPDATED EDGAR FILER MANUAL

The Commission is adopting an updated edition of the EDGAR Filer Manual and is providing for its incorporation by reference into the Code of Federal Regulations. The amendment to 17 CFR part 232 (Regulation S-T) and the new edition of the EDGAR Filer Manual (Release 5.40) will be effective on January 26, 1998. (Rel. Nos. 33-7495; 34-39558; 35-26818; 39-2361; IC-23002)

#### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

#### FORMER TRANSFER AGENT BOGUTSKI BARRED

On January 20, the Commission issued an order instituting public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Robert Bogutski, and simultaneously accepted Bogutski's Offer of Settlement.

Without admitting or denying the findings, Bogutski consented to the issuance of the order which found that on January 14, 1998, Boqutski was permanently enjoined in United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas (SEC v. EnvirOmint Holdings, Inc., et Bogutski consented to the entry of the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. The complaint alleged that Bogutski violated the antifraud and certain transfer agent recordkeeping provisions of the federal securities laws based on his participation through Idata, Inc., a registered transfer agent, in a scheme relating to the offer and sale of Environment Holdings, Inc. (EHI) securities. The complaint alleged that Bogutski destroyed Idata's securities transfer records for EHI's predecessor company, and created false or misleading transfer records for EHI. By these activities, the principals of EHI converted shares of the predecessor to themselves and their nominees, and concealed their control of the company.

The order provides that Bogutski be barred from association with any broker, dealer, transfer agent, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. (Rel. 34-39559; File No. 3-9531)

### BRIAN SCHRAUGER AND QUESTOR GROUP, INC. SETTLE ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE AND DESIST PROCEEDINGS AGAINST THEM

On January 20, the Commission issued an order instituting public administrative and cease and desist proceedings under the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), Investment Advisers Act and the Investment Company Act against Brian D. Schrauger (Schrauger) and Questor Group, Inc. (Questor), and simultaneously accepted their Offer of Settlement.

The order finds that Questor and Schrauger breached fiduciary duties owed to their advisory clients by failing to disclose conflicts of interest including, among other things, the fact that Schrauger held a financial interest in, and acted as a consultant to, some of the issuers whose securities were recommended to clients. The order also finds that they misrepresented Questor's investment strategy and primary source of income. Additionally, the order finds that Schrauger and Questor recommended unsuitable investments to clients, and violated the books and records and custody provisions of the Advisers Act.

Without admitting or denying the findings, Schrauger and Questor consented to the issuance of the order which provides that: Questor and Schrauger cease and desist from committing or causing any violations or any future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and Sections 204, 206(1), 206(2), 206(4) and 207 of the Advisers Act and Rules 204-1(b), 204-2, 204-3 and 206(4) -2 thereunder; Schrauger is barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company with the right to reapply for association after three years from the date of the Order; and Questor's registration as an investment adviser is revoked. ## PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND DEFAULTS ISSUED AGAINST NORTH CAROLINA ENTITY AND REPRESENTATIVES IN ACTION INVOLVING SALE OF FICTITIOUS JAPANESE TREASURY BONDS

The Commission today announced that the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York issued a preliminary injunction and entered defaults in a pending action involving fictitious treasury bonds purportedly issued by the Japanese government. Judge Charles Brieant issued the preliminary injunction on Friday, January 16, 1998 against five defendants: Northeast Investment Institution, Inc. (Northeast), a Fayetteville, North Carolina entity, and four representatives of Northeast including Thomas Patrick McGlon, Daniel Watlington, William Muwwakkil and Tyrone P. Jones, III. The Court also entered default as to Northeast, Watlington, Muwwakkil and

Jones as a result of their failure to plead or defend.

The Commission alleges that the Northeast defendants have offered for sale as many as 24 treasury bonds purportedly issued by the Japanese government totaling 12 billion yen (approximately [U.S.] \$120 million) in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Commission introduced evidence from the Japanese government, the U.S. Secret Service, two securities firms and a bank in support of its contention that the bonds and other documents relating to a chain of custody for the bonds are fraudulent. The relief granted includes a preliminary injunction, an order freezing the bonds, an order requiring the Northeast defendants to tender the bonds to the registry of the Court, and an order requiring accountings from the Northeast defendants. December 1997 the Commission obtained a temporary restraining order and other relief against the five defendants, and obtained preliminary injunctions and other relief against five other defendants in this action. #### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 9, 1998 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (NFG), a gas registered holding company, and each of its wholly owned subsidiaries (Subsidiaries) to engage in various financing and related transactions through December 31, 2002. These transactions would include external financing by NFG, intrasystem financing by Subsidiaries through an existing money pool arrangement, the formation of financing entities to facilitate issuance of securities, guarantees by NFG of obligations of its Subsidiaries and the use of financing proceeds by National to acquire exempt wholesale generators, foreign utility companies, energy-related companies, gas related companies and related transactions. #### NORTHEAST UTILITIES, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, to issue and sell notes (Notes) up to an aggregate of \$25 million under a supplementary revolving credit facility. (Rel. 35-26816)

#### ALABAMA POWER COMPANY, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Alabama Power Company, Georgia Power Company, Gulf Power Company

(Gulf), Mississippi Power Company, and Savannah Electric and Power Company, each an electric public utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered holding company. It is proposed that Gulf, through the Gulf Power Capital Trust II and the Gulf Power Capital Trust III, issue \$50 million aggregate liquidation amount of preferred securities. In addition, it is proposed that Gulf issue a related series of junior subordinated notes and guarantees. Jurisdiction continues to be reserved over the issuance and sale of preferred securities through December 31, 2005, as follows: \$500 million for Alabama; \$310.75 million for Georgia; \$75 million for Mississippi; and \$40 million for Savannah. #### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-97-98) through its wholly owned subsidiary the Nasdaq Stock Market, Inc. (Nasdaq) extending the temporary 50% fee reduction currently being charged for the execution of a transaction in SelectNet has become immediately effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 19. (Rel. 34-39555)
