ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS SETTLED AGAINST DEAN MCDERMOTT, STEPHEN COMPOS AND DANIEL SHAFFER

The Commission announced that on January 30, 1998, it instituted and simultaneously settled cease and desist proceedings pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) against Dean McDermott and Stephen Compos, both of Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, and Daniel Shaffer (Shaffer), of Reading, Pennsylvania (collectively, Respondents).

The Order Instituting Cease and Desist Proceedings (Order) found that from approximately May 1995 through May 1996, Respondents solicited and raised at least \$4.8 million for purported bond trading programs offered by Old Naples Securities, Inc. and James Zimmerman (Zimmerman). The Order found that instead of making the promised investments, Zimmerman operated a "Ponzi" scheme and misused and misappropriated customer funds.

The Order found that Respondents solicited these investments based solely on Zimmerman's oral representations to them and conducted an insufficient investigation into the investments. The Order also found that certain "red flags" should have caused Respondents to investigate the bond investments in greater detail. The Order finds that Respondents committed or caused violations of Sections 17(a) (2) and (3) of the Securities Act.

Pursuant to their Offers of Settlement, Respondents consented to the entry of a cease and desist order and to an order that Shaffer pay disgorgement of \$90,000 plus pre-judgment interest, all of which was waived based on Shaffer's demonstrated inability to pay. (Rel. 33-7502; File No. 3-9540)

COMMISSION SETTLES ACTIONS AGAINST J. PATRICK KITTLER AND PAUL MOUNT, CPA

The Commission announced today that it filed a civil suit in federal court in the District of Minnesota against J. Patrick Kittler, trustee and chief executive officer of National Trade Trust, a Minneapolis, Minnesota company. The complaint alleges that under Kittler's direction, the company disseminated misleading offering

materials including fraudulent financial statements that materially overstated the company's earnings, assets and net worth. These offering materials also misrepresented the safety and liquidity of the company's promissory notes. Between February 1990 and March 1994, the company raised approximately \$8 million from over 300 investors from the sale of its notes. National Trade Trust has defaulted on the notes and currently owes approximately \$6.5 million to over 200 investors. The company has ceased operations and is liquidating its remaining assets.

Kittler has consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, to the entry of an order of permanent injunction and the payment of a \$25,000 civil penalty.

In simultaneous administrative proceedings, the company's independent auditor, Paul Mount, consented to the entry of an order barring him from appearing or practicing before the Commission as an accountant for four years. Mount, through his accounting firm, Mount & Borresen, Ltd., of Bloomington, Minnesota, audited the company's financial statements for the fiscal years ended December 31, 1990, 1991 and 1992. These financial statements, together with audit reports prepared by Mount, were included in the company's offering statements filed with the Commission under Regulation A of the Securities Act of 1933.

The administrative order, which Mount consented to without admitting or denying, finds that Mount engaged in improper professional conduct by failing to obtain sufficient competent evidential matter to support his opinions, by failing to exercise due professional care, and by lacking the proper degree of professional skepticism. STOCK PROMOTERS SETTLE ALLEGATIONS THAT THEY PAID KICKBACKS TO BROKERS

The Commission announced today that two stock promoters, previously charged with paying kickbacks to brokers for selling certain securities to their clients, have settled the charges against them. On September 27, 1996, the Commission filed a Complaint in U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida alleging, among other things, that Patrick N. Kephart (Kephart), Scott Mijares (Mijares), and others, engaged in a fraudulent scheme in which they paid \$477,580 in bribes to seven stockbrokers to induce them to retail securities to the public.

Kephart and Mijares consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, to the issuance of a Final Judgment by Judge Patricia C. Fawsett of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida enjoining each from future violations of Sections 17(a) and 17(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. Kephart also consented to disgorge \$25,297.88 in profits he received from the alleged scheme, plus \$11,910.71 in prejudgment interest and

to pay a penalty of \$25,297.88. Mijares consented to disgorge \$19,002.00 in profits he received from the alleged scheme, plus \$8,946.50 in prejudgment interest and to pay a penalty of \$19,002.00. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE VIRTUS FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Virtus Funds, et al. for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit the reorganization and consolidation of series of certain registered open-end investment companies into certain series of another registered open-end investment company. (Rel. WEISS, PECK & GREER FUNDS TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by Weiss, Peck & Greer Trust, et al. for an order under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit in-kind redemptions of shares of certain registered open-end management investment companies held by shareholders who are affiliated persons of the investment companies. (Rel. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 23 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company

(National), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary company Seneca Independence Pipeline Company (Seneca) to acquire a 25% general partnership interest in Independence Pipeline Company (Pipeline), a nonassociate entity. National's nonutility subsidiary, Niagara Independence Marketing Company (Niagara), proposes to acquire a 25% general partnership interest in DirectLink Gas Marketing Company (DirectLink), a nonassociate entity. National also proposes to: (1) make direct and indirect capital contributions to Pipeline and DirectLink; and (2) add Seneca and Niagara to its authorized money pool arrangement. (Rel. 35-26821)

THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER CO., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 23 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) and Western Massachusetts Electric Company (WMECO), each an electric public utility subsidiary company of Northeast Utilities (Northeast), a registered holding company. CL&P and WMECO propose to modify a credit facility for nuclear fuel financing previously approved by the Commission. (Rel. 35-26821)

EUA ENERGY INVESTMENT CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 23 to request a hearing on a proposal by Eastern Energy Investment Corporation (EEIC) and EUA Bioten, Inc. (EUAB), each a nonutility subsidiary of Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company. EEIC and EUAB request authority to design, construct, install, operate and maintain two biomass-fired combustion turbine power generation facilities for a customer in India. EEIC and EUAB also request authority to engage in activities to develop and commercialize these types of facilities and related products and services for other customers, both inside and outside the United States. These activities would be conducted by BIOTEN Partnership (EUABP), a general partnership in which EUAB will have a 79.8% interest, either directly or through special purpose subsidiaries and/or joint ventures with nonassociates (Special Purpose Entities). In addition, EEIC and EUAB request that the Commission extend their authority to invest funds in EUABP, and authorize EUABP to invest in the Special Purpose Entities, through December 31, 2002. investments would be limited to advances under a line of credit not to exceed \$13 million outstanding and capital contributions not to exceed \$8.907 million.
