SEMIANNUAL REGULATORY AGENDA

The Commission has authorized the publication of its April 1998 Regulatory Flexibility Act Agenda. The agenda is a general announcement to the public intended to provide advance notice of rulemaking actions. The agenda, which will not be available to the public until its publication, has been submitted by the Commission to the Regulatory Information Service Center for inclusion in the Unified Agenda of Federal Regulations scheduled for publication in the Federal Register in April 1998. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

CONTESTED ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE AND DESIST PROCEEDING AGAINST AL RIZEK

On February 24, Administrative Law Judge G. Marvin Bober issued an initial decision in the administrative and cease and desist proceeding against Al Rizek (Rizek). Rizek was alleged to have violated Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder over a period from at least January 1, 1993 through at least March 31, 1994, by recommending to eight customers an aggressive strategy of trading United States Treasury zero coupon bonds on a short-term basis in order to take advantage of predicted fluctuations in the interest rate markets.

Judge Bober found that Rizek exercised control over five of the eight disputed accounts, and that he understood or recklessly disregarded the costs of his short-term trading strategy and, contrary to the investment objectives of those five customers, excessively traded their accounts. Judge Bober, therefore, found that Rizek caused violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws in five of the eight accounts at issue. As a result, Judge Bober ordered that Rizek: (1) be barred from being

associated with any broker-dealer, and from being associated with a member of a national securities exchange or registered securities association for two years after the date of this decision; (2) cease and desist from committing or causing any violations or future violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder; (3) disgorge unjust commissions of \$277,038, plus prejudgment interest from April 1, 1994; and (4) pay a civil penalty of \$100,000. COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST EIGHT NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE FLOOR BROKERS, SEVEN BROKER-DEALERS AND TWO INDIVIDUAL PRINCIPALS OF A BROKER-DEALER ALLEGING ILLEGAL TRADING ON THE FLOOR OF THE EXCHANGE

The Commission today filed a civil enforcement action in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York alleging that William S. Killeen (Killeen) and Thomas W. Bock (Bock), the principals of The Oakford Corporation (Oakford), a registered broker-dealer, entered into unlawful profit sharing arrangements with eight New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) floor brokers, including defendants Thomas J. Cavallino, Edward J. Mueger, Robert J. Carucci, Christine A. Beyer, Michael A. Frayler, Mark R. Savarese, John J. Savarese and John R. D'Alessio (collectively, the Floor Brokers). Pursuant to these arrangements, Bock and Killeen opened accounts at Oakford and falsely identified the accounts as Oakford proprietary trading accounts, when the accounts were, in fact, controlled by the defendant Floor Brokers. Thereafter, the Floor Brokers illegally traded through the accounts and split the profits and losses with Oakford, generally with the Floor Brokers receiving 70% of the profits, and Oakford receiving the balance. Between October 1993 and December 1996, this scheme netted illegal profits totaling at least \$11.1 million. The complaint also alleges that the defendants deliberately falsified various books and records, including order tickets.

The Commission's complaint charged the defendants with violating, or aiding and abetting violations of, Sections 11(a) and 17(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 11a-1, 17a-3 and 17a-5 thereunder and NYSE Rules 90(a), 95(a) and 111(a). The complaint seeks permanent injunctive relief, disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil money penalties.

The Commission's action is a result of an investigation with the United States Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York, the Internal Revenue Service Criminal Investigation Division, the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the NYSE. JOHN CHARGED WITH ANTIFRAUD AND REGISTRATION VIOLATIONS

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint and ex parte temporary restraining order on February 20 against David A. Colvin, Job Kjell Hovik, Lamar Ellis, John Larson (a/k/a John St. John), Intellinet Publishing, Inc, Intellinet Holding Group, Inc., Medical Advantage, Inc., Lamelli, Inc. d/b/a Lamelli Medical Technology, Inc., and Wall Street Research Company, Inc. alleging violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws in connection with the defendant's offering of 120 day demand notes to investors. The complaint alleges that the defendants misrepresented and/or omitted material information to investors concerning statements that former Surgeon General C. Everett Koop and Television Journalist Tom Brokaw had endorsed one of the defendant's companies. The complaint also alleges that defendants falsely claimed that one company had National Institutes of Health approval for a purported detoxification machine. The Court appointed a temporary receiver and froze the assets of some defendants. [SEC v. David A. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE MONITOR FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 23, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by The Monitor Funds, et al. for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit the reorganization of certain series of a registered open-end management investment company into certain series of another registered open-end management investment company. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 16, 1998, to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, its utility subsidiaries and certain nonutility subsidiaries to increase CSW's

aggregate short-term borrowing limitation from \$1.2 billion to \$2.5 billion, add certain nonutility subsidiaries to the CSW intrasystem money pool, and related transactions. (Rel. 35-26831)

COLUMBIA ENERGY GROUP, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 16, 1998, to request a hearing on a proposal by Columbia Energy Group (CEG) (formerly Columbia Gas System), a registered holding company, and all of its nonutility subsidiaries (Nonutility Subsidiaries). CEG and the Nonutility Subsidiaries seek authority to engage in certain consumer-oriented businesses previously authorized without certain limitations imposed under current authority. In addition, CEG and the Nonutility Subsidiaries seek authority to engage in a broad range of energy-related businesses serving customers inside and outside the United States, either directly or indirectly through to be established or acquired subsidiaries (New Subsidiaries). These businesses would include, but not be limited to, energy management services, energy-related asset management services, technical consulting services, and utility-related consumer services. Also, CEG and the Nonutility Subsidiaries seek authority for the New Subsidiaries to join the system money pool. CEG and the Nonutility Subsidiaries request that the Commission reserve jurisdiction over the proposed sale of goods and services to customers outside the United States, other than energy management services and technical consulting services, pending completion of the record. WISCONSIN ENERGY CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 16, 1998, to request a hearing on a proposal by Wisconsin Energy Corporation (WEC), an exempt Wisconsin intrastate electric public utility holding company, to acquire all of the issued and outstanding common stock of ESELCO, Inc. (ESELCO), an exempt Michigan intrastate electric public utility holding company. In addition, WEC proposes to continue its exemption from all provisions of the Act except Section 9(a)(2), following consummation of the proposed transaction. (Rel. 35-26831)

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 16, 1998, to request a hearing on a proposal by Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Blackstone Valley Electric Company, Montaup Electric Company, Newport Electric Corporation and Eastern Edison Company (collectively, Declarants). The Commission previously authorized the Declarants to issue and sell notes (Notes) under a revolving credit facility (Facility). Declarants now propose to supplement the Facility, from time to time through July 31, 2002, through the issuance and sale of new short-term notes (New Notes). Declarants propose that the aggregate amount of Notes and New Notes outstanding at any one time will not exceed \$350 million. (Rel. 35-26831)

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 16, 1998, to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company. NEES proposes to issue, no later than December 31, 2002, up to one million shares of its common stock to be used to acquire the stock or assets of one or more "energy-related companies," as defined in Rule 58 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935, as amended. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> to clarify requirements for peer review of auditors of foreign issuers (SR-NASD-98-16) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 23. (Rel. 34-39688)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-98-09) to amend its circuit breaker trading halts rule. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 23. (Rel. 34-39689)

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-97-13) to amend NSCC's Rules and Procedures regarding membership standards to allow for consideration of applicants and participants' regulatory history. ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Emerging Markets Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-EMCC-98-01) relating to the offering of shares of common stock. APPROVAL OF EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY REGISTRATION AS A CLEARING AGENCY

The Commission has approved a request by the <u>Government Securities</u> <u>Clearing Corporation</u> for extension of its registration as a clearing agency under Section 17A of the Act until February 28, 1939. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 2, 1998. (Rel. 34-39696)

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> to strike from listing and registration Industrial Technologies, Inc., Common Stock, \$.01 Par Value. (Rel. 34-39697)
