AMENDMENTS TO RULES ON SHAREHOLDER PROPOSALS

On May 21, the Commission adopted amendments to Rules 14a-8, 14a-4, and 14a-5 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. As part of these amendments, the Commission also reversed the 1992 Cracker Barrel no-action letter. The reversal of the no-action letter is effective May 21, 1998 and will apply to future no-action responses, including currently pending no-action submissions. EXTENSION OF COMPLIANCE DATE FOR RULE AMENDMENTS CONCERNING INVESTMENT COMPANIES' FOREIGN CUSTODY ARRANGEMENTS

The Commission has issued a release that extends the compliance date for certain amendments to Rule 17f-5 under the Investment Company Act, the rule that governs the custody of investment company assets with certain "eligible foreign custodians" outside the United States. Effective upon publication of the release in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u>, the compliance date for the rule amendments that the Commission adopted in May of 1997 (Rel. No. IC-22658) is extended from June 16, 1998 to February 1, 1999, except for the amended definition of an eligible foreign custodian. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST GEORGE STEWART, ET AL.

The Commission announced that the Honorable Loretta A. Preska of the United States District Court of the Southern District of New York has entered a final judgment against George Wallace Stewart in <u>SEC</u> <u>v. Stewart, et al.</u>, Civil Action No. 98 CIV 2636 (LAP) (S.D.N.Y.).

On April 14, 1998, the Commission filed a complaint alleging as follows: Stewart along with four other individuals and five related entities fraudulently obtained more than \$1.7 million, from at least three individuals, by offering and selling securities in the form of participations in investment programs purportedly to trade "prime bank" instruments. The investment programs were scams, the instruments themselves bogus. Instead of using the money as promised, Stewart and the other defendants misappropriated the investors' funds for their own benefit, transferring portions of the money to at least one individual and three entities, who were named as relief defendants. By participating in this fraudulent investment scheme, Stewart and the other defendants violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

Stewart consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to the entry of the final judgment, which permanently prohibits him from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The final judgment waives disgorgement and civil money penalties were not imposed against Stewart based on his demonstrated inability to pay.

Litigation continues as to the remaining nine defendants and four relief defendants. [SEC v. Stewart, et al., Civil Action No. 98 CIV 2636, SDNY] (LR-15752)

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST TERRY SHILLING ALLEGING UNLAWFUL INSIDER TRADING IN SECURITIES OF HEALTHSOURCE, INC.

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint alleging that Terry S. Shilling (Shilling), a former Healthsource, Inc. (Healthsource) executive and a resident of Marietta, Georgia, engaged in unlawful insider trading in the securities of Healthsource. The complaint, filed in the United States District Court for the District of New Hampshire, alleges that, on February 20, 1997, Shilling bought 1,900 shares of Healthsource after being informed by a Healthsource executive, in a confidential briefing, that Healthsource was engaged in merger negotiations with CIGNA Corporation. The complaint alleges that Shilling, by trading ahead of the February 28, 1997 announcement that CIGNA would acquire Healthsource, realized unlawful profits of \$10,761.78. Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, Shilling consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to the entry of an order enjoining him from future violations of certain antifraud provisions of the securities laws and ordering him to pay disgorgement of \$10,761.78, plus prejudgment interest, and a civil money penalty of \$10,761.78. COMMISSION FILES INSIDER TRADING CASE

The Commission announced the filing of a civil injunctive action in the United States District Court for the District of Colorado against William Benjamin Lockwood, alleging that, on September 11, 1996, the defendant exercised options for 1,500 shares of the common stock of BI and sold the shares thereby obtained for \$10 7/16 per share. According to the complaint, at the time of this transaction, Lockwood was in possession of material nonpublic information indicating that BI would not meet consensus estimates for earnings for the quarter. The complaint alleges that, by selling his BI shares at \$10 7/16 per share, the defendant avoided losses of \$5,468.00.

Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, the defendant consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to the entry of a Final Judgment permanently enjoining him from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and ordering that he disgorge profits from his transactions in the securities of BI of \$5,468.00, plus prejudgment interest of \$508.00, pay a one-time civil penalty of \$5,468.00, and pay postjudgment interest. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BOSTON 1784 FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 15, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by Boston 1784 Funds (Trust) and BankBoston, N.A. under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and (B) of the Act, under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act exempting applicants from Sections 17(a)(1) and 17(a)(2) of the Act, and under Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act permitting certain joint transactions. The requested order would permit certain registered open-end management investment companies to invest excess cash and cash collateral in affiliated money market funds in excess of the limits in Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and (B) of the Act. U.S. GLOBAL LEADERS VARIABLE INSURANCE TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 15, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by U.S. Global Leaders Variable Insurance Trust (Fund) and Yeager, Wood & Marshall, Inc. (Adviser). Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder to the extent necessary to permit shares of any current or future series of the Fund and shares of any other investment company that is designed to fund variable insurance products and for which the Adviser, or any of its affiliates, may serve now or in the future as investment adviser, administrator, manager, principal underwriter or sponsor, to be offered and sold to, and held by variable annuity and variable life insurance separate accounts of both affiliated and unaffiliated life

insurance companies, qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context, and the Adviser or any of its affiliates. (Rel. IC-23199 - May 20)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WISCONSIN ENERGY CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing Wisconsin Energy Corporation (WEC), an exempt Wisconsin intrastate electric public utility holding company, to acquire all of the issued and outstanding common stock of ESELCO, Inc. (ESELCO), an exempt Michigan intrastate electric public utility holding company. WEC requests an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) from all provisions of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935, as amended, except Section 9(a)(2), following consummation of the proposed transaction. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> (SR-PHLX-98-10) to adopt a new automatic price improvement initiative for PACE orders. (Rel. 34-40006)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change and issued notice of filing and granted accelerated approval to Amendment No. 1 to the proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Municipal Securities</u> <u>Rulemaking Board</u> (SR-MSRB-98-1) to provide an interpretation of Rule G-38 on consultants relating to bank affiliates and the definition of payment. Publication in the Federal Register is expected during the week of May 25. (Rel. 34-40014)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> (SR-CHX-98-5). The rule change amends Interpretation .01 to Article XXXIV, Rule 16, which governs registered market makers' utilization of exempt credit. (Rel. 34-40016)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Amex-97-40) relating to proposed revisions to the Exchange's policy regarding the use of wireless data communications devices. (Rel. 34-40019)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-98-12) filed by the <u>Philadelphia</u> <u>Stock Exchange</u> relating to trading options in finer increments has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> during the week of May 25. (Rel. 34-40007)

The Commission received a filing requesting immediate effectiveness of a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-98-17) by the <u>American Stock</u> <u>Exchange</u> relating to the listing and trading Of warrants on the PaineWebber Oil & Gas Producers Index. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 25. (Rel. 34-40008)

A proposed rule change filed by the <u>Pacific Exchange</u> to remove the current cap on the number of issues traded under the Lead Market Maker Book Pilot Program (SR-PCX-98-23) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 25. (Rel. 34-40020)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-98-11) to amend CBOE Rule 12.3, "Margin Requirements," to allow clearing firms to adjust a market maker's equity under certain circumstances to permit the clearing firm to extend credit for opening trades. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 25. (Rel. 34-40015)

ACCELERATED PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> filed, and the Commission has granted partial accelerated approval to, on a temporary basis, a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-98-09), relating to modifications to the SuperMAX and Enhanced SuperMAX programs.
