#### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

#### ROBERT COWAN BARRED IN SETTLED ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

The Commission announced the institution of public administrative proceedings under the Investment Advisers Act against Robert C. Cowan and Cowan Asset Management, Inc. (CAMI), an investment adviser registered with the Commission and wholly owned by Cowan, and simultaneously accepted the offers of settlement by Cowan and CAMI. The Order issued by the Commission bars Cowan from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company, and revokes CAMI's registration as an investment adviser.

The Commission found that on June 2, 1997, Cowan and CAMI were permanently enjoined by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas [SEC v. Robert C. Cowan, et al., 5:96CV-224-C). Cowan was enjoined from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and violations and aiding and abetting violations of Sections 206(1), (2) and (4) of the Investment Advisers Act, and Rule 206(4)-2 thereunder. CAMI was enjoined from violations of Sections 206(1), (2) and (4) of the Advisers Act and Rule 206(4)-2 thereunder. Previously, on April 3, 1997, Cowan pled guilty to a charge of mail fraud as set out in a criminal information filed by the United States Attorney for the Northern District of Texas, Lubbock Division, (U.S. v. Robert C. Cowan, 5:97CR-0023-C).

The Commission's complaint against Cowan and CAMI alleged that Cowan sold in excess of \$3 million in interests in CS Investment Trust, a fictitious investment company, to CAMI's advisory clients and others, promising fixed, guaranteed returns ranging as high as 14% per annum. In fact, Cowan used the funds raised from investors to pay his personal business and living expenses, and to fund CAMI's operations. (Rel. IA-1724; File No. 3-9612)

#### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS ENTERED AGAINST AND SIMULTANEOUSLY SETTLED BY CHRISTOPHER HALL AND HOWE, SOLOMON AND HALL, INC.

The Commission announced that it instituted and simultaneously settled public administrative and cease and desist proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b), 19(h), and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Christopher J. Hall (Hall) and Howe, Solomon and Hall, Inc. (HSH), both of Miami, Florida.

The order instituting the proceedings (Order) finds from September 7, 1994 to October 12, 1994, HSH, a broker-dealer registered with the Commission, willfully violated the federal securities laws by charging excessive markups on certain municipal securities that it sold to its customers. The Order further finds that Hall, HSH's Chief Financial Officer, willfully aided and abetted and caused HSH's violations.

In the Order, the Commission accepts HSH and Halls' Offer of Settlement (Offer), in which, while neither admitting nor denying the allegations in the proceeding, HSH agrees to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations and any future violations of Section 15B(c)(1) of the Exchange Act and Rules G-17 and G-30 promulgated by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (MSRB), to pay an administrative penalty of \$25,000, and to pay disgorgement and prejudgment interest of \$135,412. Hall agrees in the Offer to a censure and to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations and any future violations of Section 15B(c)(1) of the Exchange Act and Committing or causing any violations and any future violations of Section 15B(c)(1) of the Exchange Act and of MSRB Rules G-17 and G-30. #### CRIMINAL INDICTMENT AGAINST ROBERT WEEKS AND DAVID HESTERMAN

The Commission and the United States Attorney for the District of Utah announced the filing late yesterday of a criminal indictment charging two men from Salt Lake City, Utah with three counts of securities fraud in connection with sales of stock in PanWorld Minerals International, Inc. The indictment filed in the United States District Court for the District of Utah charges Robert G. Weeks and David A. Hesterman, PanWorld's then president and consultant, with failing to tell PanWorld's auditor during the 1992 audit that the company's principal asset, the Las Rosas mine in Chile, was overvalued at \$3,473,000 for several reasons. It is alleged that Weeks and Hesterman failed to tell the auditor that the mine could not be operated at a profit, that they had failed to deliver 3 million shares of preferred stock in payment for the mine, and that they had arbitrarily valued the preferred stock at \$1 per share. The indictment also charges Weeks and Hesterman with making similar false statements in PanWorld's 1992 annual report filed with the SEC about Las Rosas and failing to disclose that the Europa Mill, which processed ore from the mine, had been repossessed. The indictment also charges Weeks and Hesterman with making false statements in PanWorld's March 1993 quarterly report with the SEC by including the Washington Gulch placer mine located in Montana as an

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asset worth approximately \$5.5 million, when in fact the company did not own Washington Gulch. Weeks and Hesterman also failed to disclose Hesterman's 1984 criminal conviction for securities fraud. [U.S. v. Robert G. Weeks and David A. Hesterman, D. Utah, 2:98CR0728S] (LR-15758)

## COMPLAINT FILED AND ORDER FREEZING ASSETS ISSUED AGAINST EDWARD SNYDER AND ROBERT CARROLL

The Commission announced that on May 22 it filed a complaint seeking preliminary and permanent injunctions and an immediate asset freeze against Edward Snyder, of San Diego, California and Robert E. Carroll, of Keswick, Virginia, alleging the defendants had violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

The complaint alleges that from October 1997 to March 1998, Snyder and Carroll obtained funds from investors by representing that Carroll would invest their money in a prime bank investment program which would yield returns of from 17% to 100% per month. The complaint further alleges that none of these funds obtained from investors were invested in such a program and that, instead, investor funds were deposited in a brokerage account maintained by Carroll and used to purchase shares in a money market fund and to pay Carroll's personal expenses.

On May 22, the Honorable Barefoot Sanders, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Texas, issued an order freezing the assets of Snyder and Carroll. Judge Sanders also scheduled a court date of June 1, 1998, for a hearing on the Commission's motion for preliminary injunction. [SEC v. Edward Snyder and Robert E. ## PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND OTHER RELIEF ORDERED AGAINST WALTER CLARENCE BUSBY

On May 1, the Honorable Thomas W. Thrash, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Georgia, entered an order of permanent injunction and other relief against Walter Clarence Busby (Busby). The order permanently enjoins Busby from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1993 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Busby was ordered to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$15,000 representing the gains he received from sales of interests in three prime bank schemes, along with prejudgment interest thereon. Payment of the disgorgement and prejudgment interest was waived based upon Busby's sworn financial statement which indicate an inability to pay the ordered amounts.

Busby consented to the relief without admitting or denying the allegations set forth in a complaint, filed by the Commission on September 11, 1997. In its complaint, the Commission alleged that Busby violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by offering and selling investment contracts in connection with three different prime bank schemes. Using misrepresentations and omissions in each of the three schemes, Busby raised money for purported trading programs in "prime bank" notes by fraudulently representing to investors that the investments were risk-free and that the ventures would pay returns ranging from 750% to 10,000%. In total, Busby raised nearly \$1 million from more than 70 investors. None of the investors earned the exorbitant returns promised by Busby. [SEC v. #### DEAN WITTER SELECT EQUITY TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Dean Witter Select Equity Trust and Dean Witter Select Investment Trust (Trusts) and Dean Witter Reynolds Inc. under Sections 6(c), 12(d)(1)(J) and 17(b) exempting applicants from Sections 12(d)(1)(F) and 17(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits certain trusts of funds relying on Section 12(d)(1)(F) of the Act to offer units with a sales load in excess of the 1.5% limit in Section 12(d)(1)(F)(ii).

Also, the order amends a prior order and permits terminating series of the Trusts to sell certain investment shares and fixed income securities issued by the United States government to new series of the Trusts. (Rel. IC-23209 - May 27)

#### EXTENDED STAY AMERICA, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Extended Stay America, Inc. under Section 3(b)(2) of the Investment Company Act declaring applicant is primarily engaged in a business other than that of investing, reinvesting, owning, holding, or trading in securities. (Rel. IC-23210 - May 27)
