RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

AMENDMENT TO RULE 9b-1 PROPOSED

The Commission proposed an amendment to Rule 9b-1 relating to the Options Disclosure Document to refine the language of the Rule so that it more clearly reflects the regulatory standards it was designed to establish. The amendment is intended to strengthen Rule 9b-1 while continuing to ensure a regulatory scheme that fosters investors' understanding of the characteristics and risks of standardized options. SEC PROPOSES TO REVISE RULE 135b UNDER THE SECURITIES ACT OF 1933

Today the Commission announced that it was soliciting comments on a proposal to revise Rule 135b. The proposal provides that an options disclosure document prepared in accordance with Rule 9b-1 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 is not a prospectus and, accordingly is not subject to civil liability under Section 12(a)(2) of the Securities Act. The proposal is intended to codify a longstanding interpretive position that was issued immediately after the Commission adopted the current registration and disclosure system applicable to standardized options. The proposed revision is intended to eliminate any legal uncertainty in this area. (Rel. 33-7550; File No. S7-19-98)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FRANK BERGER CONSENTS TO THE ENTRY OF A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

On June 25, the Commission instituted administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Frank Berger (Berger). The Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing a Cease and Desist Order (Order) finds that during the relevant period, Berger held himself out as the Chairman of Bio-Tech Industries, Inc. (formerly Twenty First Century Health, Inc.). On February 10, 1997, the Commission

issued an order suspending trading in the securities of Bio-Tech for a ten-day period pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Exchange Act. The Order finds that on February 13, 1997, Bio-Tech, based on information supplied by Berger and others, issued a materially false and misleading press release that Berger reviewed prior to its being issued. The Order further finds that the following day, on February 14, 1997, Bio-Tech issued another materially false and misleading press release that Berger reviewed before its being issued. Simultaneously with the institution of the administrative proceedings, the Commission accepted Berger's offer of settlement in which he consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to the issuance of the Order which orders Berger to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation or any future violation of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AGAINST CHRISTOPHER PEDERSEN

The Commission announced that on June 25 it issued an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceeding (Order) against Christopher M. Pedersen, the sole owner and principal of a formerly registered broker dealer, City First Securities Corporation dba City Associates Investment Corporation. The Commission's Order alleges that Pedersen was enjoined by a United States District Court from future fraud and registration violations. In its complaint in the District Court action, the Commission alleged that Pedersen made material misrepresentations and omissions in connection with the offer and sale of interests in various investment programs concerning, among other things, the purchase of bonds purportedly backing oil and gas limited partnership investments, the use of funds raised for investment programs and the financial stability of the entities through which the investment programs were offered. The complaint also alleged that Pedersen withdrew undisclosed salary advances and officer loans from the entities and investment programs, and did not disclose that the entities were in serious financial decline from at least July of 1991.

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations and to afford the Respondent an opportunity to present any defenses thereto. The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether the allegations are true and whether any remedial action should be ordered by the Commission. For further information see (SEC v. PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST KATHY KINGSMORE

On May 21, 1998, Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief were entered against defendant Kathy S. Kingsmore (K. Kingsmore) and relief defendant Richard E. Kingsmore (R. Kingsmore). Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint, K. Kingsmore consented to be permanently enjoined from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Commission's complaint charged that K. Kingsmore offered and sold purported "Prime Bank" investments in the form of Eurobonds, which she claimed were fully insured by a trust account she maintained at Barclay's Bank in London. According to the complaint, K. Kingsmore, who promised some investors that they would double their money in as little as two weeks, raised at least \$3 million from approximately 34 investors in several states. The complaint further alleged that K. Kingsmore misappropriated a significant portion of investor funds for her own personal use.

The Court further ordered that K. Kingsmore and relief defendant R. Kingsmore pay disgorgement in the amount of \$3,376,846, jointly and severally, representing the gains they received as a result of the conduct alleged in the complaint, plus prejudgment interest of \$599,382.87. Based on K. Kingsmore and R. Kingsmore's demonstrated financial inability to pay the full disgorgement amount, payment of all but \$761,493.27 of the disgorgement, and all of the prejudgment interest, is waived. [SEC v. Kathy S. THREE ATTORNEYS ORDERED TO DISGORGE FEES RECEIVED IN VIOLATION OF ASSET FREEZE ORDER

The Commission announced that on June 19 the Honorable Richard A. Paez of the Central District of California issued an Order Granting Motion For Disgorgement against three attorneys for Defendant Carroll E. Siemens. The Commission had sought disgorgement of approximately \$187,500 in legal fees received by the attorneys in violation of the Court's June 23, 1994, order freezing Siemens' assets. In granting the Commission's motion, the Court found that the attorneys received ill-gotten funds from Siemens with knowledge of the Court's freeze order.

The Court ordered that by July 20, 1998, attorneys Arthur H. Barens and Richard C. Chier of Los Angeles, California, disgorge to the Court-appointed Receiver \$19,011.49 and \$27,500 respectively. The Court further stated that it will order disgorgement by Chier of an additional \$78,000 Siemens claims he paid to Chier unless Chier submits an accounting or documentation by July 20, 1998, showing that such additional disgorgement is not appropriate. Finally, the Court ordered that by July 20, 1998, attorney Nelson Segel of Las Vegas, Nevada, to whom Siemens claimed he paid \$65,000, provide a complete accounting of all sums received from Siemens so that the Court may determine the amount to be disgorged by Segel. OLD MUTUAL SOUTH AFRICA EQUITY TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Old Mutual South Africa Equity Trust (Trust), Old Mutual Global Assets Fund Limited (Fund) and Old Mutual Asset Managers (Bermuda) Limited for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order permits the Trust to purchase certain securities from the Fund. (Rel. IC-23264; International Series Rel. 1142 - June 23)

THE EMERGING GERMANY FUND INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 20, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by The Emerging Germany Fund Inc., a registered closed-end management investment company. Applicant requests an order under Section 6(c) of the Act granting an exemption from Section 19(b) of the Act and Rule 19b-1 under the Act to permit it to make up to four distributions of net long-term capital gains in any one taxable year, so long as it maintains in effect a distribution policy with respect to its common stock calling for quarterly distributions of a fixed percentage of its net asset value. VARIABLE INSURANCE PRODUCTS FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 20, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by Variable Insurance Products Fund (VIPF), Variable Insurance Products Fund II (VIPF III), and Variable Insurance Products Fund III (VIPF III) (together, Applicants). Applicants seek an amended order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for exemptions from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Act, and Rules 6e-2(b) (15) and 6e-3(T) (b) (15) thereunder, to the extent necessary to permit shares of VIPF, VIPF II and VIPF III, as well as shares of any future funds for which Fidelity Management & Research Company (FMR) or any affiliate of FMR serves as manager, advisor, principal underwriter or sponsor to be issued to and held by qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. PIMCO FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by PIMCO Funds, et al. for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order permits PIMCO Municipal Bond Fund to acquire all of the assets and assume all of the liabilities of the Tax Exempt Fund, a series of PIMCO Funds. Because of certain affiliations, applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-23270 - June 24)

SIRROM CAPITAL CORPORATION

An order has been issued on an application filed by Sirrom Capital Corporation for an order under Section 61(a)(3)(B) of the Investment

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Company Act approving applicant's Amended and Restated 1995 Stock Option Plan for Non-Employee Directors. The order supersedes an existing order. (Rel. IC-23271 - June 24)
