ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

AMERICAN AUTOMATION, INC., KENDYLL HORTON, HAZEL HORTON AND MERLE GROSS

The Commission announced today that Judge Fitzwater, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, granted the Commission's request for an emergency restraining order to halt the fraudulent money raising efforts of American Automation, Inc., Kendyll R. Horton, Hazel A. Horton and Merle B. Gross of According to the Commission's complaint, the Irving, Texas. defendants raised at least \$3 million from some 486 investors in several states through the fraudulent offer and sale of American Automation, Inc. stock. The Hortons and Gross represented to investors that American Automation would develop and market its automated insurance vending machines in high traffic areas; projected profits would be almost \$100 million by the end of its third year of operation; and the company would make a public offering which would significantly increase the value of the American Automation stock. It appears that no automated vending machines have been sold and that American Automation's only source of revenue came from investor funds. Additionally, according to the complaint, the defendants used investor funds to pay for their personal expenses, including cars, clothing and living expenses, and for business expenses unrelated to American Automation's operations.

The temporary restraining order, entered on July 10, by Judge Fitzwater, enjoins American Automation, Kendyll R. Horton, Hazel A. Horton and Merle B. Gross from violating the federal securities laws and includes an order freezing the assets of the defendants and relief defendants, MuscleWear, Inc., Angel World Insurance Group, Inc., Direction Management Co., LLC, Lord & Kendyll Investments, Inc., and Family Light Co., LLC, companies believed to be controlled by one or more of the defendants.

In its complaint, the Commission alleges that defendants have violated Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Commission also seeks an order permanently enjoining American Automation, Kendyll R. Horton, Hazel A. Horton and Merle B. Gross, an order requiring disgorgement of all wrongfully obtained profits with prejudgment interest, and civil penalties against each defendant, as well as disgorgement with prejudgment interest against the relief defendants. In addition, the Commission seeks the appointment of a receiver to conserve assets for the benefit of investors. [SEC v. American Automation, Inc., Kendyll R. Horton, Hazel A. Horton and Merle B. TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST ASSOCIATION OF INDIVIDUAL MINISTRIES

The Commission announced that on July 9 it filed an emergency action in federal court to halt a religious pyramid scheme, the Association for Individual Ministries, or AIM, based in Palm Desert, California. The Commission charged AIM and Charles Groeschel with defrauding investors by promising huge returns in exchange for their "donations." Groeschel, a former Baptist pastor, aged 66, uses Biblical language to solicit investments. The Commission alleged that AIM transferred funds to a corporation controlled by Groeschel, Sage Computer Services, which is also named as a defendant, and that AIM had transferred over \$200,000 to an off-shore bank account after Groeschel learned that the Commission was investigating AIM. Since mid-1996, the Commission alleges, AIM has taken in at least \$1.5 million, from over 2,000 investors. The Commission sought a freeze of assets and other emergency relief.

Judge Robert P. Patterson, Jr., of the Southern District of New York, granted the Commission's emergency application, finding at a hearing on July 9 that the Commission had presented sufficient facts to demonstrate the likelihood of succeeding with its complaint. Judge Patterson ordered a freeze of all assets controlled by Groeschel, AIM and Sage, and ordered that a receiver be appointed for Sage and AIM. The temporary restraining order and order to show cause also ordered an accounting of investor proceeds, repatriation off-shore funds, protection of documents, and expedited of In its complaint, the Commission seeks permanent discovery. injunctions against future violations of the anti-fraud provisions of the securities laws, as well as disgorgement and civil penalties against Groeschel, AIM and Sage. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW YORK LIFE CAPITAL CORPORATION

An order has been issued on an application filed by New York Life Capital Corporation under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting relief from all provisions of the Act. The order would permit applicant to sell certain debt securities and use the proceeds to finance the business activities of its parent company and certain companies controlled by the parent company. (Rel. IC-23309 - July 9)

MCLAUGHLIN, PIVEN, VOGEL SECURITIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 4, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by McLaughlin, Piven, Vogel Securities, Inc. for a conditional order under Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicant from the disqualification provisions of Section 9(a) solely with respect to a securities related injunction entered against one of applicant's affiliates. The conditional order would permit applicant to act as sponsor, depositor, and principal underwriter for one or more unit investment trusts. (Rel. IC-23310 - July 10)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW CENTURY ENERGIES, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 4, 1998, to request a hearing on a proposal by New Century Energies, Inc., a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary, Public Service Company of Colorado, and NC Enterprises, Inc., a wholly owned nonutility subsidiary of New Century (collectively, Applicants). Applicants seek authority to: 1) acquire 50% of the equity securities of WYCO Development LLC (WYCO), for an investment not to exceed \$26 million; 2) have WYCO acquire two pipeline projects; and 3) enter into sales leaseback transactions for the Front Range and Power River facilities. (Rel. 35-26894)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-98-20) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 relating to the eligibility requirements for the Retail Automatic Execution System for OEX and DJX options. Publication of the order is expected to appear in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 13. (Rel. 34-40186)

The <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SRCHX-98-13) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act relating to amendments to the Exchange's clearing the post policy for cabinet securities. Publication of the order is expected to appear in the <u>Federal</u> Register during the week of July 13. (Rel. 34-40187)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Amex-97-39) under Rule 19b-4 to allow members to trade in increments smaller than sixteenths under limited circumstances. (Rel. 34-40189)

The Commission granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change (SR-EMCC-98-5) filed by the <u>Emerging Markets Clearing</u> <u>Corporation</u> under Section 19(b) of the Exchange Act. The proposal will permit EMCC to process cash payments made on warrants for which there are outstanding fail receive and fail deliver obligations, and to permit EMCC to pair-off outstanding warrant fail receive obligations with fail deliver obligations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 13. (Rel. 34-40190; International Series Rel. No. 1145)

The Commission granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-98-5) filed by <u>The Depository Trust Company</u> under Section 19(b) of the Exchange Act. The proposed rule change will implement shared control accounts. (Rel. 34-40191)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-NSCC-97-13) under Section 19(b)(2) of the Exchange Act that permits the NSCC to establish membership standards that allow for consideration of applicants' and participants' regulatory history. WITHDRAWAL

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 30 to comment on the application of Financial Federal Corporation to withdraw its Common Stock, \$.50 Par Value, from listing and registration on the <u>American Stock Exchange</u>. (Rel. 34-40188)
