ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

T. ROWE PRICE AND ASSOCIATES, INC.

Public administrative proceedings have been ordered under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against T. Rowe Price and Associates, Inc., a registered investment adviser with its principal place of business located in Baltimore, Maryland. Rowe Price submitted an offer of settlement which the Commission has accepted.

The order for proceedings alleges that from May 1972 until the date of the order, Rowe Price, in connection with its discretionary "mini-account" advisory service, known as the Managed Portfolio Program (MPP), violated the antifraud provisions of the Advisers Act by failing to adequately and accurately disclose the amount of individualized treatment provided to each MPP account and the extent to which investment decisions for such accounts would be made and implemented based upon "model portfolios". Without admitting or denying the allegations Rowe Price consented to the entry of an order censuring Rowe Price and finding violations as alleged. (Rel. IA-658)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY
