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COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

EXAMINATION SWEEP OF PENNY STOCK FIRMS FINDS MAJOR DROP IN PENNY STOCK ACTIVITY

A joint examination sweep by federal, state and self-regulatory organizations has found that regulatory efforts to curb the widespread penny stock fraud of the late 1980s have sharply reduced U.S. penny stock activity.

This was among the key findings of the 1993 Penny Stock Examination Sweep released yesterday by the Securities and Exchange Commission, National Association of Securities Dealers, New York Stock Exchange, and the North American Securities Administrators Association.

The Penny Stock Sweep was the largest cooperative examination effort ever undertaken by regulators. A total of 225 examiners and other personnel participated in the examination program, which covered 129 broker-dealers identified as having some current or past business in the penny stock market. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FRED FILIPOVIC AND CHARLES SHEETS SANCTIONED

The Commission announced that it has entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Fred Filipovic (Filipovic) and Charles Sheets (Sheets). Filipovic and Sheets consented to the issuance of the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings. The Order contained findings that from at least August 1989 through October 1989, Filipovic, the president of a registered broker-dealer, and Sheets, a registered representative associated with the broker-dealer, willfully violated the securities registration provisions of the federal securities laws. Specifically, the Order finds that Filipovic offered and sold the unregistered securities of Eurobond Exchange Ltd. (Eurobond) to two investors thereby raising \$22,000. The Order further finds that Filipovic oversaw the activities of Sheets who offered and sold the unregistered Eurobond securities to six investors raising an additional \$86,000. As a result of such findings, the Order requires Filipovic and Sheets to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations and committing or causing any future violations of the securities registration provisions of the federal securities laws. The Order also suspends Filipovic and Sheets from associating with any regulated entity for 90 days. Finally, the Order bars Filipovic from associating with such entities in a supervisory or proprietary capacity. (Rels. 33-7067; 34-34242)

THE COMMISSION ORDERS TODMAN & CO. TO IMPLEMENT QUALITY CONTROL PROCEDURES

The Commission announced today the institution of a proceeding pursuant to Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Todman & Co. (Todman), a partnership engaged in the practice of public accounting. Simultaneous with the institution of the proceeding, Todman consented to the issuance of an Order Instituting Proceedings and Opinion and Order of the Commission. The Commission's Order finds that Frederick S. Todman & Co. (FST), a partnership previously engaged in the practice of public accounting was dissolved on December 31, 1993 and that Todman was organized on the same day. Todman is comprised of eight partners, two of whom are former partners of FST. The Commission's Order also finds that, as a result of three previous actions against FST and FST personnel, the Commission has had concerns regarding the internal controls of FST over accounting and auditing functions. Accordingly, Todman has consented to the entry of the Order requiring it to implement certain procedures designed to provide additional assurance that it has appropriate quality controls. Todman has agreed to retain a consultant,

acceptable to the Commission, to periodically review the adequacy of Todman's quality control procedures and the firm's compliance with those procedures, and the audit performance of Todman's staff and partners. Todman is required to implement all of the consultant's recommendations. The consultant will also review a representative sample of audit reports, financial statements and audit workpapers. Finally, Todman has agreed to be suspended forthwith from appearing and practicing before the Commission should Todman fail materially to comply with the terms of the Order. INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST POLLUTION RESEARCH AND CONTROL CORP., ALBERT GOSSELIN AND CYNTHIA GOSSELIN

On June 28, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia seeking permanent injunctions against Pollution Research and Control Corp. (PRCC), a NASDAQ company that manufactures air pollution control devices, its chief executive officer, Albert E. Gosselin, Jr. (Gosselin), and its chief financial officer, Cynthia Gosselin. Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint the defendants consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, to the entry of final judgments of permanent injunction. In addition, Gosselin agreed to pay a \$25,000 civil penalty.

The complaint alleges violations by PRCC of the antifraud, securities registration, books and records and internal control provisions of the federal securities laws; violations by Gosselin of the antifraud provisions; and record-keeping violations by Cynthia Gosselin. In 1989 and 1990 quarterly and annual reports Gosselin allegedly caused PRCC to materially understate operating losses and overstate assets in connection with its accounting for the acquisition and disposition of two subsidiaries, and its reporting of assets, including notes receivable from employees, inventory and accounts receivable. The complaint also alleges that PRCC engaged in unregistered public distributions of its securities. [SEC v. Pollution Research and Control Corp., et al., Civ. No. 94CV01425, TFH, D.D.C.] (LR-14139)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Cincinnati Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CSE-94-06) to amend and extend the pilot on the floor of the exchange relating to the preferencing of public agency orders by approved dealers and other proprietary members. Publication of the proposal in the Federal Register is expected during the week of June 2. (Rel. 34-34258)

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-92-09) to prohibit the use of PACE volume execution guarantees with offsetting orders in low-volatility, high-volume stocks in order to "trade the quote spread." Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 4. (Rel. 34-34259)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Government Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-GSCC-94-5) that modifies GSCC's fee structure. Publication of the proposed rule change is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 4. (Rel. 34-34260)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL ON A TEMPORARY BASIS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved on a temporary basis, through June 30, 1995, proposed rule changes filed by the National Securities Clearing Corporation, Midwest Clearing Corporation, and Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia (SR-NSCC-94-09, SR-MCC-94-06 and SR-SCCP-94-02). The rule changes authorize the continuance of NSCC's, MCC's and SCCP's procedures that guarantee the settlement of participant trades at an earlier date in their Continuous Net Settlement systems and use certain revised clearing fund calculations to protect against any increased risk caused by such earlier guarantees. PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND AMENDMENT THERETO

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-94-17) and filed Amendment No. 1 thereto, relating to firm-quote responsibilities. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 4. (Rel. 34-34262)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
