COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC AND BIB ANNOUNCE ACCORD ON EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

Chairman Breeden and Anders Sahlen, Chairman and Director General of the Swedish Bank Inspection Board (BIB), today issued a Communique on the Exchange of Information and the Establishment of a Framework for Cooperation between the SEC and the BIB (International Series Release No. 292, June 27, 1991). Citing the growing interest in cross-border investment between the United States and Sweden, the SEC and the BIB recognize the need to enhance mutual cooperation in the administration and enforcement of the U.S. and Swedish securities laws. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WNC HOUSING TAX CREDIT FUND III

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by WNC Housing Tax Credit Fund III, L.P., a California limited partnership (Partnership), and its general partner, WNC Tax Credit Partners, L.P., a California limited partnership. The application is for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Act.
