COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN BREEDEN TO TESTIFY

Chairman Breeden will testify before the Senate Subcommittee on Securities on Thursday, July 25, at 9:30 a.m. Subject of the hearing is the SEC reauthorization. It will take place in Room 538 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE ACTION AGAINST JAMES MCLAMB AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed sanctions imposed by the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) on James Carlton McLamb, of Raleigh, North Carolina. McLamb was a former assistant vice president and registered representative with Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. The Exchange concluded that McLamb should be permanently barred from membership, allied membership, approved person status and from employment or association in any capacity with any member or member organization.

During 1983 and 1984, Merrill Lynch operated an in-house system for trading odd-lot market orders so that customers could buy and sell to the firm at or around current round-lot prices, without being charged an odd-lot differential. The Commission found, as had the NYSE, that, during the period from October 1983 to July 1984, McLamb took advantage of that system by executing 73 trades at prices that were more favorable to himself and his customers than the prices allowed by the firm's procedures.

In affirming the sanctions imposed by the NYSE, the Commission stated that, "by taking advantage of a system that relied on his integrity, McLamb benefited himself and others at his employer's expense [and] breached his fundamental duty of loyalty to his employer." (Rel. 34-29446)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HUDSON INCOME SHARES

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Hudson Income Shares, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. '(Rel. IC-18246 - July 23)

ROCHESTER GROWTH FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 19 to request a hearing on an application filed by Rochester Growth Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18247 - July 23)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued concerning New England Power Company (NEP), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of New England Electric System, a registered holding company. The order allows NEP to extend its authorization to incur indebtedness in excess of 10%, but in no event greater than 20%, of the sum of the principal amount of all outstanding bonds and other secured indebtedness and the capital, premium and retained earnings of NEP. (Rel. 35-25352)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 7 to comment on the application of Spaghetti Warehouse, Inc. to withdraw its Common Stock, \$0.01 Par Value, from listing and registration on the <u>American Stock Exchange</u>. (Rel. 34-29454)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-90-13) filed by the Options Clearing Corporation under Rule 19b-4 relating to an electronic mail service to be offered and fees to be charged in connection with the service. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 22. (Rel. 34-29460)

AMENDMENTS TO THE PLAN FOR REPORTING OF CONSOLIDATED OPTIONS LAST SALE REPORTS AND QUOTATION INFORMATION

The Options Price Reporting Authority filed with the Commission, pursuant to Rule 11Aa3-2 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, an amendment to the Plan for Reporting of Consolidated Options Last Sale Reports and Quotation Information. The amendment establishes a fee to be paid by persons who provide back-up facilities to OPRA subscribers, including access to current options market information. Persons wishing to offer this service will be required to enter into a "Back-Up Facility Provider Agreement" and to pay a Back-Up Facility Access Fee and, under certain circumstances, additional device charges. Publication of the release was expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 1. (Rel. 34-29465)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-91-26) under Rule 19b-4 to amend CBOE Rule 3.6 to delete redundant language regarding authorization for nominees of member organizations. The rule change would also codify the current Exchange policy that requires individual members and certain persons associated with member organizations to pledge to abide by the CBOE Constitution and Rules. Finally, the rule change would require that all members keep and maintain a current copy of the Rules. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 22. (Rel. 34-29466)
