COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED ON RULE 2(e) (7)

LIBRARY

The SEC today announced the extension of time for submitting comments on a proposed amendment to Rule 2(e) (7) of its Rules of Practice from May 20 to June 19, 1974. As proposed, the revised rule would provide that proceedings pursuant to Rule 2(e) arising out of charges against professionals practicing before the Commission would be public unless the Commission, on its own motion or at the request of a party, should direct otherwise.

To be considered, written statements of views and comments should be submitted to the Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, Washington, D. C. 20549, on or before June 19. All communications should refer to File No. S7-520, and will be available for public inspection. (Rel. 33-5496)

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SUSPENSION OF REGULATION B EXEMPTION OF OLYMPIC PETROLEUM CORPORATION MADE PERMANENT

The Commission's order temporarily suspending the claimed Regulation B exemption from the Securities Act's registration requirements with respect to an offering of working oil and gas interests of Olympic Petroleum Corporation of Dallas, Texas has become permanent.

The order alleged that the Commission has reason to believe that Olympic:
(1) offered and sold working interests before any offering sheet was in effect;
(2) failed to disclose that the issuer's controlling person had been enjoined from violations of the securities laws; and (3) failed to file reports on Form 1-G as required.

The order was made permanent because Olympic Petroleum Corporation withdrew its request for a hearing. (Rel. 33-5494)

SUSPENSION OF REGULATION A EXEMPTION OF KIOWA REAL ESTATE INVESTMENT TRUST MADE PERMANENT

The Commission's order temporarily suspending the claimed Regulation A exemption from the Securities Act's registration requirements with respect to an offering of 30,000 shares of beneficial interest in Kiowa Real Estate Investment Trust of Kiowa, Colorado, has become permanent. The temporary order alleged that the Commission had reason to believe that: (1) the statements in the offering circular about the issuer's financial condition were incorrect; (2) the circular did not disclose that the offering had begun without meeting the requirements of Colorado law; and (3) issuer's Form 2-A Report was inaccurate as to the date on which the offering began. The order was made permanent because the issuer withdrew its answer and its request for a hearing. (Rel. 33-5495)

TRADING SUSPENSIONS

COOK TREADWELL & HARRY TRADING HALTED

The SEC announced the suspension of over-the-counter trading in all securities of Cook Treadwell & Harry Inc., subsidiary of Cook Industries, Inc., located in Memphis, Tenn., for a ten-day period beginning May 18 and terminating at midnight (EDT) on May 27, 1974. Trading had originally been suspended in the company's securities on May 8 and that suspension had terminated May 17.

The Commission initiated the suspension because questions have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of the financial statements of Cook Treadwell & Harry. Cook Industries requested the suspension. (Rel. 34-10814)

ADDITIONAL ACTION ON TRADING SUSPENSIONS

The SEC has announced the suspension of (a) over-the-counter trading in the securities of Technical Resources, Inc. for the ten-day period May 17-26, inclusive; (b) exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Canadian Javelin, Ltd. and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Royal Properties, Inc. and Winner Industries, Inc. for the further ten-day period May 18-27, inclusive; (c) exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of BBI, Inc. for the further ten-day period May 19-28, inclusive; and (d) over-the-counter trading in the securities of Westgate California Corporation for the further ten-day period May 20-29, inclusive.

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

COMPLAINT NAMES COMMONWEALTH CHEMICAL SECURITIES, OTHERS

The New York Regional Office announced the filing of a complaint in the U.S. District Court for New York on May 8, seeking to enjoin the following from violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of securities of Beneficial Labs, Inc.: Commonwealth Chemical Securities, Inc., New York broker-dealer; Robert Drucker, of Englewood Cliffs, N.J., Commonwealth vice president; Julius Kleinman, of New York City, Commonwealth president; Beneficial Labs, Inc., of Oceanside, N.Y.; John Feldman, of Oceanside, N.Y., Beneficial president; DK & B Management, Inc., New York investment adviser; Mary Sharpe, of New York City, Commonwealth's bookkeeper; Zoltan Guttman, also known as Lou Goodman, of Brooklyn, N.Y., Commonwealth's cashier; Marlane Kleinman, also known as Marcia Klein, of New York City, Kleinman's wife and former Commonwealth registered representative; Dorothy Drucker, also known as Dorothy Rukasin, of Englewood Cliffs, N.J., Drucker's wife; Cabot-Shaw, Inc., of Beverly Hills, Calif., broker-dealer; Darold Myles Shirwo, of Beverly Hills, Calif., president of Cabot-Shaw; Gerald Wolff, of Van Nuys, Calif., former registered representative and trader at Cabot-Shaw; Vincent Caccese, of Brooklyn, N.Y., former registered representative and trader at a former New York City broker-dealer; and Michael Rekon, of Clark, N.J., former registered representative and trader at a former New York City registered broker-dealer. The investigation leading to the filing of this action was conducted by a joint SEC-NASD Task Force. (LR-6372)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

OHIO POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Ohio Power Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), to sell \$100 million of first mortgage bonds at competitive bidding and AEP to make a cash capital contribution to Ohio Power of \$20 million. (Rel. 35-18419)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 25 to request a hearing on a proposal of Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to sell \$130 million of first mortgage bonds and \$60 million of preferred stock at competitive bidding. The proceeds will be used to finance 1974 construction, to pay notes payable, and for other corporate purposes. (Rel. 35-18420)
