COMMISSION REQUESTS PUBLIC COMMENT ON REGISTRATION OF FOREIGN INVESTMENT COMPANIES

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The Commission announced that it was requesting public comment on the issues concerning the standards for permitting foreign investment companies to register under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and making public offerings of their securities in the United States. The request is for comment on a broad range of policy questions concerning the registration under the Act of and access to United States markets by foreign investment companies, particularly those companies domiciled in countries which are members of the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development. All comments on these issues should be addressed to George A. Fitzsimmons, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commis-sion, 500 North Capitol St., N.W., Washington, D.C. 20549. ASSISTANT REGIONAL ADMINISTRATORS (CHICAGO) NAMED

> William D. Goldsberry, Administrator of the Chicago Regional Office, announced the appointment of William M. Hegan and Dennis J. Waldeck as Assistant Regional Administrators of the Commission's Chicago Regional Office. Mr. Hegan's duties will be primarily in the area of enforcement, and Mr. Waldeck will be in charge of the Commission's regulatory program for the Chicago Regional Office.

> Mr. Hegan joined the staff of the Chicago Regional Office in January, 1963 as a staff attorney. He was promoted to Chief, Branch of Enforcement in 1967 and has served in that capacity until the present time. Mr. Hegan was named Special Assistant United States Attorney in 1968 to prosecute a securities fraud case and again in 1969 to argue in the Court of Appeals for affirmance of a securities fraud conviction. Mr. Hegan, who resides in Chicago, Illinois, received an AB (Honors) Degree from Loyola University of Chicago and a JD Degree from the University of Chicago Law School.

> Mr. Waldeck joined the staff of the Chicago Regional Office in April of 1965. He served as a staff attorney in the Branch of Enforcement until June 1969, when he was assigned to the Chicago Regional Office's Branch of Reorganization. He became Chief of that Branch in August 1972. In August of 1973 he was appointed Chief of the Branch of Enforcement and has served in that capacity until the present time. Mr. Waldeck received his bachelor's degree and law degree from Loyola University of Chicago. Mr. Waldeck, his wife and two children reside in Glen Ellyn, Illinois.

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

RICHARD C. PISTELL ENJOINED

The SEC announced that on November 13 Judge Edward Weinfield of the Southern District of New York issued an order enjoining Richard C. Pistell from violating the antifraud and other provisions of the securities laws. Pistell consented to the order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint. The civil action, which is pending against other defendants, charged Pistell with a series of acts relating to the business of General Host Corporation of which he was chairman at the time of their occurrence. As a part of its mandatory relief of disgorgement, the Court ordered that Pistell pay interest to an affiliate of General Host on money he had borrowed from it. (SEC v. General Host Corp., et al., U.S.D.C. S.D.N.Y., Civil Action No. 73-275). (LR-6611)
