CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PAUL V. WINTERS, JR., ENVIRONMENTAL LANDFILLS, INC. PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The New York Regional Office announced that, on March 23, U.S. District Judge Kevin Thomas Duffy, Southern District of New York, permanently enjoined Environmental Landfills, Inc., owner of a closed landfills site in upstate New York, and Paul V. Winters, Jr., its Chief Executive Officer, from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Complaint of March 14, 1990, alleged that Wellshire Securities, Inc. supplied false and misleading information about Environmental Landfills to the investing public to induce customers to purchase or retain Environmental Landfills securities. The Complaint further alleged that much of that false and misleading information was supplied to Wellshire by Winters. Also, the Complaint alleged that Environmental Landfills issued a false and misleading press release in or about January 1989. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, Winters and Environmental Landfills consented to the permanent injunction. [SEC v. Wellshire Securities, Inc., et al., 90 Civ 1707 (KTD) (U.S.D.C., S.D. N.Y.)] (LR-12445)
