U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FIRST VARIABLE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act, exempting First Variable Life Insurance Company, Fund BE of First Variable Life Insurance Company (Fund BE), Fund E of First Variable Life Insurance Company (Fund E), and Monarch Financial Services, Inc. from Section 17(a) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the transfer of accumulation value under certain variable annuity contracts from Fund BE to Fund E, and under Section 26(b), approving the substitution of shares of Variable Investors Series Trust for shares of Benham Variable Insurance Series Trust. (Rel. IC-17484 - May 10)

RCS EMERGING GROWTH FUND

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act, amending an existing order and exempting RCS Emerging Growth Fund from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1. The order permits the Fund to waive its contingent deferred sales load on redemptions by certain specified categories of shareholders in addition to those waivers permitted by the existing order. (Rel. IC-17485 - May 11)

KOREA FUND

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting the Korea Fund, Inc., et al and any other registered investment company or series thereof for which Scudder, Stevens & Clark, Inc., Scudder Fund Distributors, Inc., or an affiliate thereof acts as investment adviser or principal underwriter, from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 to the extent necessary to permit each applicant to invest in equity or convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. (Rel. IC-17486 - May 11)

RENAISSANCE CAPITAL PARTNERS

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by Renaissance Capital Partners III, Ltd. (Partnership), Renaissance Capital Group, Inc. (Managing General

Partner) and Ernest C. Hill and Don M. Patterson (Independent General Partners) under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act, determining that: (i) the Independent General Partners are not "interested persons" of the Partnership or of the Managing General Partner within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Act solely by reason of being general partners of the Partnership; and (ii) limited partners owning less than 5% of the Partnership units are not "affiliated persons" of the Partnership or of other limited or general partners within the meaning of Section 2(a)(3)(D) of the Act solely by reason of their status as limited partners.
