#### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

HARBOUR BAY FINANCIAL CO., LAURA M. MARABLE, AND ROBERT STINSON, JR., TEMPORARILY ENJOINED

On May 25, the Commission announced the filing of a Complaint in the U. S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania against Harbour Bay Financial Company (Harbour Bay), Laura M. Marable (Marable), and Robert Stinson, Jr. (Stinson). In its Complaint, the Commission seeks a temporary restraining order, preliminary and permanent injunctions, disgorgement and prejudgment interest, a freeze of assets, and an order of accounting. The Honorable James T. Giles, United States District Court Judge, with the consent of the defendants, entered the temporary restraining order, freeze of assets, and order of accounting, pending a preliminary injunction hearing on May 31, 1990.

The Complaint alleges violations of the antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the federal securities laws. In its Complaint, the Commission alleges that, from at least December 1989 through the present, the defendants have failed to register Harbour Bay as a broker, but have induced and attempted to induce the purchase and sale of securities for the accounts of others. The Complaint alleges that Harbour Bay, through Marable and Stinson, are soliciting the business of raising venture capital in the form of public and private placements. In addition, since at least December 1989, the defendants have sold securities in a television broadcasting venture, in the form of limited partnership interests. The Complaint also alleges that the defendants misled investors about the use and disposition of their proceeds, the risks associated with their investments, their status as an unregistered broker, the amount of the broadcasting venture's assets, and Stinson's previous convictions for mail and wire fraud. The Complaint alleges that the defendants misappropriated investor proceeds. (SEC v. Harbour Bay Financial Company, et al., Civil Action No. 90-3580) (LR-12488)

#### CHASE MANHATTAN BANK

(Chase), for an order exempting certain registered investment companies, Chase, and Chase Manhattan Bank Espana, S.A. from Section 17(f) of the Investment Company Act to permit Chase to deposit the securities of such investment companies in Chase Manhattan Bank Espana, S.A. (Rel. IC-17505 - May 23)

# EQUITABLE FUNDS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 19 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Equitable Funds, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act, exempting applicants from Sections 18(f), 18(g) and 18(i) of the Act. (Rel. IC-17506)

### GOLDEN AMERICAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Golden American Life Insurance Company, The Specialty Managers Separate Account B of Golden American Life Insurance Company (Separate Account B), and Directed Services, Inc. from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of Separate Account B under certain deferred and immediate variable annuity contracts, and to permit the deduction of a guaranteed death benefit charge from the accumulation value under the deferred annuity contract. (Rel. IC-17507 - May 24)

# KIDDER, PEABODY & COMPANY

Kidder, Peabody & Company, Inc. (Kidder) has been granted a temporary order under Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act, and seeks a permanent order, exempting Kidder and any affiliated person of Kidder from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit Kidder or an affiliated person of Kidder to employ Mr. Stanley S. Trotman, Jr., an individual who is subject to a securities-related injunction. The temporary order will expire on the earlier of ninety days from the entry of the temporary order, the date on which the SEC sets Kidder's application for permanent relief for a hearing, or the date on which the SEC takes final action on the application. Interested persons have until June 19 to request a hearing on Kidder's request for a permanent order. (Rel. IC-17509 - May 24)

#### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

## NORTHEAST UTILITIES

An order has been issued authorizing Northeast Utilities (Northeast) in connection with the formation of a new dividend reinvestment plan (DRIP), which will purchase shares of common stock directly from Northeast or on the open market, to issue and sell to the DRIP, from time to time through December 31, 1995, up to 10 million shares

of its common stock (\$5 par) under an exception from competitive bidding. (Rel. 35-25093)

#### MONONGAHELA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Monongahela Power Company, The Potomac Edison Company, and West Penn Power Company, each a wholly owned public-utility subsidiary of Allegheny Power System, Inc., to issue and sell up to \$50 million, \$130 million and \$130 million aggregate principal amount, respectively, of their first mortgage bonds in one or more series, from time to time not later than February 29, 1992, with maturities of from five to thirty years, the proceeds of which will be used for general corporate purposes and to refund, prior to their respective maturities, certain of their outstanding first mortgage bonds. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
