NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION AGAINST EDWARD DAVID BRAVERMAN

On May 18, 1990, U.S. District Court Judge Kevin Thomas Duffy, Southern District of New York, issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Default as to Edward David Braverman (Braverman), which permanently enjoins him from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Complaint filed on March 14, 1990, alleges that Braverman was employed by Wellshire Securities, Inc. from approximately June through October 1989. The Complaint further alleges that, while associated with Wellshire, Braverman engaged in various violative sales practices and made materially false and misleading statements about Ventura Inc. to members of the investing public. MICHAEL C. BEATTY ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on June 1, Judge Diana Murphy of the U.S. District Court for the District of Minnesota granted the Commission's Motion for an Order of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief by Default (Order) against Michael C. Beatty (Beatty). The Order enjoins Beatty from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Beatty was further enjoined from offering for sale any security or commodity, opening or trading in any brokerage accounts or engaging in the purchase or sale of any security or commodity. Finally, Beatty was ordered to disgorge \$1,469,000.

The Complaint alleged that Beatty raised over \$4 million in the offer and sale of interests in four limited partnerships, ITS-1985-I, ITS-1986-VIII, ITS 1987-X and ITS-1987-XI, and unregistered securities in the form of promissory notes issued by Investment Tax Services, Inc. Further, the Complaint alleged that, in the sale of these securities, Beatty made material misrepresentations and omissions concerning the safety of the investment, the use of proceeds, his disciplinary history, and the risks associated with the investment. CRIMINAL CONTEMPT GUILTY PLEA ENTERED

The United States Attorney for the Western District of Oklahoma and the Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on May 21, 1990, Wesley Karban Wyatt of Stillwater and Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pled guilty to an Information which charged Wyatt with criminal contempt of an Order of Permanent Injunction entered against him on August 19, 1977, in SEC V. Financial Planning Corporation of America and Wesley Karban Wyatt, (W.D. Okla. No. CIV-77-0815-D). Wyatt was sentenced by United States District Judge David Russell to a two-year prison term on each of four counts, with the sentences to run concurrently.

Wyatt had been enjoined in 1977 from further violations of provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 in connection with the unlawful offer and sale of securities in the form of personal investment notes. The Information charged Wyatt with willful disobedience of the Order from at least July 14, 1989, when Wyatt again began to offer and sell promissory notes. Wyatt had received approximately \$940,000 from these activities.

The case was investigated by the Fort Worth Regional Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission, the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Oklahoma Securities Department. (LR-12503)

LLOYD SECURITIES, INC., MORTGAGE ASSOCIATES, IBEX INTERNATIONAL, MICHAEL W. LLOYD AND WARREN C. NACHMANN TEMPORARILY ENJOINED

On June 6, 1990, the Philadelphia Regional Office filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania against Lloyd Securities, Inc. (Lloyd Securities), Mortgage Associates, IBEX International (IBEX), Michael W. Lloyd (Lloyd) and Warren C. Nachmann (Nachmann). The Commission seeks a temporary restraining order, preliminary and permanent injunctions, disgorgement, a freeze of assets, and an order of accounting. On June 7, 1990, the Honorable Herbert J. Hutton, United States District Judge, entered a temporary restraining order, including the freeze of assets, and an order of accounting, pending a preliminary injunction hearing on June 15, 1990.

The Complaint alleges violations of the antifraud, registration and net capital provisions of the federal securities laws. During 1989 and 1990, Lloyd Securities, a broker-dealer controlled by Lloyd and Nachmann, engaged in a scheme to defraud its customers by removing funds from customer accounts without authorization and converting customer funds to their own use. As part of the scheme to defraud customers, Mortgage Associates, Lloyd and Nachmann offered, and purportedly used customer funds to purchase, unregistered securities. (LR-12504)

FRANK CLARKE AND CO., INC. PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Philadelphia Regional Office announced that on 1990, Judge Herbert J. Hutton, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, entered a Final Judgment and Order of Permanent Injunction against Frank Clarke and Co., Inc. The Order permanently enjoins Frank Clarke and Co., Inc., a registered government securities broker-dealer, from future violations of various provisions of the Exchange Act and Treasury Rules thereunder. Clarke and Co. consented to the entry of the Order without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint.

The Complaint alleges that Clarke and Co. violated various provisions of the Exchange Act and Treasury rules thereunder in that it failed to become a member of a securities association registered under Section 15A of the Exchange Act, failed to have and maintain the required amount of liquid capital, failed to make, keep and preserve records of liquid capital computations, failed to prepare and file financial reports with the Commission, and failed to comply with the telegraphic notice requirements. NOTICE OF FILING OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE BY THE AMERICAN STOCK EXCHANGE

Pursuant to Rule 19b-4 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the American Stock Exchange, Inc. has filed with the Commission a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-90-06) to provide listing guidelines for certain unit investment trusts that permit investors to separate securities into distinct trading components. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
