The Commission released the following materials at the June 12 meeting of the Emerging Markets Advisory Committee: the agenda; the proposed working group structure; the proposed working group assignments; and the seating chart. (Press Rel. 90-34)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

# CNG TRANSMISSION CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 2 to request a hearing on a proposal by CNG Transmission Corporation (Transmission), a wholly owned gas pipeline subsidiary of Consolidated Natural Gas Company (Consolidated), to acquire a 6.4% general partnership interest in the Iroquois Gas Transmission System (Iroquois). Transmission also proposes to organize a new wholly owned subsidiary, CNG Iroquois (CNGI), which would assume Transmission's proposed partnership interest in Iroquois. CNGI would issue and sell, and Transmission proposes to acquire 1,200 shares of CNGI common stock (\$10,000 par) for \$12 million, which CNGI may occasionally purchase from Transmission, hold as treasury shares and resell to Transmission. Additionally, Transmission proposes to make open account advances to CNGI, which, together with the common stock, will aggregate a maximum of \$12 million. Transmission will also provide guarantees and indemnities on CNGI's behalf of up to \$12 million at any one time. Transmission further proposes to provide services to CNGI with respect to its obligations to Iroquois, and CNGI proposes to enter into a services agreement with Consolidated Natural Gas Service Company, Inc., Consolidated's service subsidiary. # NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 2 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities (NU) to create and acquire all of the common stock of a new wholly owned subsidiary (HEC Inc.), which would acquire substantially all of the assets of HEC Energy Corporation, which currently provides energy management services to large institutional customers primarily in New England, for a purchase price curently estimated to be \$16 million, plus a premium not to exceed \$1,055,000. NU also requests authority, through June 30, 1993: (1) to make up to \$6 million of capital contributions to HEC Inc.; (2) for HEC Inc. to borrow up to \$15 million under a revolving credit/term loan agreement to be entered into with a bank or a group of banks; and (3) to make up to \$4 million of additional capital

contributions to, or guarantees on behalf of, HEC Inc. As an alternative to the Revolving Agreement, NU proposes that it lend up to \$15 million, through December 31, 1990, directly to HEC Inc. In addition, NU seeks authorization for its system service company, Northeast Utilities Service Company, to provide services to HEC Inc. (Rel. 35-25102)

# AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY MCN CORPORATION

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until July 2 to request a hearing on proposals by: AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC. (AEP) to buy, for \$300,000, 2,100 shares of common stock of Ohio Valley Electric Corporation (OVEC) from Louisville Gas and Electric Company, a publicly owned gas and electric public utility company, thereby increasing AEP's ownership interest in OVEC from 42.1% to 44.2%; and MCN CORPORATION (MCN), a public utility holding company which is exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Holding Company Act under Rule 2, to acquire all of the outstanding common stock of Citizens Gas Fuel Company, a Michigan gas utility company. # NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 2 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES) to extend the period through which it is authorized to issue and sell its authorized but unissued shares of common stock (\$1 par) (Common Stock), under the New England Electric System Companies Incentive Thrift Plan II (Plan) (Rel. 35-24753, Nov. 22, 1988), and to issue and sell to the Plan an additional one million shares of its authorized but unissued shares of common stock (Additional Common Stock) from December 31, 1992 to December 31, 1994.
