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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SANCTIONS IMPOSED ON IRI ASSET MANAGEMENT, INC. AND IRI SECURITIES CORP.

The Commission announced the acceptance of an Offer of Settlement submitted by IRI Asset Management, Inc. (IRI Asset) and IRI Securities Corp. (IRI Securities) in response to the Commission's institution, on August 14, 1989, of public administrative proceedings against them. IRI Asset and IRI Securities, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the entry of an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions which finds that IRI Asset failed to reimburse two mutual fund clients for expenses in excess of a contractual limitation, accepted a management fee while no reimbursement was made, and failed to disclose its poor financial condition. The Order also finds that IRI Asset provided false information to the Funds concerning the reimbursement of these expenses which information was included in the registration statement and prospectus for the Funds and that IRI Securities, an affiliated person of an affiliated person of the Funds, sold securities to the Funds while acting as principal.

Accordingly, the Commission suspended the registration of IRI Asset as an investment adviser for 90 days and suspended the registration of IRI Securities as a brokerdealer for 45 days from the date of the Order. (Rel. 34-28098)
