INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MINNESOTA MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Minnesota Mutual Life Insurance Company, MIMLIC Sales Corporation, MIMLIC Series Fund, Inc.
