COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

RICHARD M. KOSNIK APPOINTED CHIEF

Linda C. Quinn, Director of the Division of Corporation Finance, announces the appointment of Richard M. Kosnik to the position of Chief of the Office of International Corporate Finance of the Division, effective today. That Office is responsible for the development and implementation of the rulemaking and interpretive initiatives of the Division in the area of offerings by foreign issuers in the United States and multinational offerings by foreign and domestic issuers.

Prior to joining the Commission, Mr. Kosnik was in private practice with SimpsonThacher & Bartlett in New York for eight years, spending two years in the firm's London office. Mr. Kosnik is a 1977 cum laude graduate of Harvard University and received has law degree from Georgetown University Law Center in 1982.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

T. ROWE PRICE U.S. TREASURY MONEY FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by T. Rowe Price U.S. Treasury Money Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17730 - September 6)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 24 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, to establish a Leveraged Employee Stock Option Plan (LESOP) through which \$500 million of CSW's common stock would be purchased, either on the open market or directly from CSW from shares it repurchases in the open market, in order to prefund for 30 years the purchase of CSW's common stock for the Central and South West Corporation Thrift Plan (Thrift Plan). The LESOP will finance the acquisition of CSW's common stock through the issuance of notes through December 31, 1991, in an amount not to exceed \$500 million, to CSW or to institutional lenders, which CSW proposes to guarantee. Loans to the LESOP by CSW may be financed by CSW through the issuance and sale of commercial paper, medium term notes or notes to institutional lenders through December 31, 1991, in the amount of \$500 million. A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 27 to comment on the application of NS Group, Inc. to withdraw its Common Stock (No par) and Preferred Stock Purchase Rights from listing and registration on the <u>American Stock Exchange</u>. (Rel. 34-28414)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> (SR-NYSE-90-37) to allow the NYSE to list warrants based on the Financial Times-Stock Exchange 100 Index (Rel. 34-28399). Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of September 3.

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-90-36) that gives the Board of Governors (Board) the authority to change the size and composition of the Board and the number and configuration of the NASD districts. In addition, this rule actually changes the composition and number of districts and gives the Board the authority to compensate Governors, the Chairman of the Board and members of any committee of the Board or any District Committee. (Rel. 34-28406)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Section 19b-4 of Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by the following: The <u>American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-AMEX-90-17) to allow options principal members and limited trading permit holders to trade certain derivative products in addition to standardized options (Rel. 34-28401); and the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-90-35) to change Articles II and III of the NASD Code of Procedure. The proposed rule changes the structure of the National Business Conduct Committee and revises the disciplinary procedures and review process. (Rel. 34-28405) Publication of the proposals is expected in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> during the week of September 3.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes by the following: <u>National Association</u> of <u>Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-90-37) to amend the OTC Bulletin Board Service (Service) by expanding the Service's morning period for quotation updates in foreign securities/ADRs by one half-hour, resulting in a morning update period from 8:30 to 9:30 a.m. E.T. as opposed to the original 9:00 to 9:30 a.m. E.T. morning period (Rel. 34-28404); and <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> regarding operational procedures governing the Exchange's Retail Automatic Execution System (RAES) in equity options (SR-CBOE-89-27) and Standard & Poor's 500 (S&P 500) stock index (SPX/NSX) options (SR-CBOE-89-29). (Rel. 34-28411) Publication of the orders in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the weeks of September 3 and 10.

AMENDMENTS TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-AMEX-90-06) filed an amendment to a proposed rule change under Section 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to provide listing guidelines for certain investment trusts. (Rel. 34-28410) Publication of the proposal is expected to appear in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of September 10.

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed and have become effective under Section 19b-4 by the following: <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> (SR-MSE-90-14) to amend the Exchange's fee schedule to waive Item Charge and Value Charge fees for firms routing orders in Tape B eligible securities to the MSE floor for the time period beginning on the date of this order until December 31, 1990 (Rel. 34-28402); and <u>National Securities Clearing</u> <u>Corporation</u> (SR-NSCC-90-16) clarifying NSCC's policy regarding submission of lockedin trade data by Qualified Special Representatives. (Rel. 34-28415) Publication of the proposed rule changes is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the weeks of September 3 and 10.

MISCELLANEOUS

JOINT INDUSTRY PLAN -- IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENTS

The participants in the Consolidated Tape Association (CTA) plan and the Consolidated Quotation (CQ) plan on August 21 submitted amendments to the restated CTA and CQ plans created pursuant to Rule 11Aa3-1(b)(2) and Rule 11Aa3-2(b) under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The purpose of the amendments is to revise the form of vendor/computer input user agreement (Consolidated Form), which the participants originally filed with the Commission on October 12, 1989, to incorporate certain changes recommended by commentators to the participants' original filing of the Consolidated Form. (Rel. 34-28407) Publication is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of September 10.

ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
