TERRI LEE GRAFF ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that, on August 1, Judge Milton Shadur entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Terri Lee Graff enjoining her from future violations of various antifraud and reporting provisions. The Final Judgment also ordered Graff to disgorge ill gotten gains, including prejudgment interest, in the amount of \$5900. Graff consented to the entry of the Final Judgment.

The Complaint alleged that Graff, who was the disclosed president, director and principal shareholder of GSS Venture Capital Corp., participated with Arnold Kimmes, Michael Wright and Thomas Quinn, among others, in a scheme to defraud the purchasers of GSS and Max, Inc. securities. The Complaint alleged that the scheme involved, among other things: creating GSS and Max and controlling them through undisclosed principals; raising money through blind pool public offerings that were secretly dominated and controlled; artificially raising the public trading price of GSS and Max common stock through a variety of manipulative devices; and selling GSS and Max common stock acquired in nominee names or in otherwise controlled accounts at the artificially inflated prices to investors in the United States and abroad. #### COMPLAINT NAMES CHARLES A. OGLEBAY, III, SEVEN OTHERS

On September 11, the Commission filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland against Charles A. Oglebay, III (Oglebay), Ralph E. McKittrick (McKittrick), Thomas L. Oglebay, Harold M. Covert, Harold M. Covert & Associates, Inc., Glenn E. Dawson, McKittrick & Briggs Securities, Inc., and Reliance Leasing Company. The Complaint seeks injunctions against future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, together with disgorgement and prejudgment interest.

The Complaint alleges that from 1983 through 1987, the defendants fraudulently sold approximately \$57 million in unregistered securities to 800 investors through a company called Governmental Financial Services (GFS). Investors were told that their proceeds would be used to purchase equipment leases and that GFS would remit the income from the leases in the form of a stream of periodic payments. According to the Complaint, the defendants made false and misleading statements of material facts concerning collateral of the leases, cash reserves and insurance, the default rate of the leases, the degree of risk and the receipt of commissions. The Complaint further alleges that Oglebay and McKittrick misappropriated \$2,882,485, used proceeds from new investors to pay existing investors, and oversold the leases. [SEC v. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### NATIONAL AUSTRALIA BANK LIMITED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 5 to request a hearing on an application filed by National Australia Bank Limited for an order under Section 6(c) permitting its wholly-owned subsidiary, National Nominees Limited, to maintain securities and other assets of United States investment companies outside of United States. #### ALLIED IRISH BANKS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 5 to request a hearing on an application filed by Allied Irish Banks, PLC, a commercial bank in Ireland, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Act in connection with the issuance and sale of its equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-17737 - September 11)

MORGAN GUARANTY TRUST COMPANY OF NEW YORK

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 5 to request a hearing on an application filed by Morgan Guaranty Trust Company of New York (Morgan) for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Morgan from the provisions of Section 17(f) of such Act and Rule 17f-5 thereunder to permit Morgan to continue to deposit foreign securities in accordance with a previous exemptive order despite Morgan's intention to sell its ownership interest in the foreign custodian. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>New York Stock</u> <u>Exchange</u> (SR-NYSE-90-19) that improves the procedural rules under which its arbitration proceedings are administered and institutes new fees applicable to the use by its members of the Exchange's arbitration forum. (Rel. 34-28421)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-AMEX-90-13) filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act to amend AMEX Rule 7 and its Commentary to make technical amendments and to specify that normal short sale restrictions would be applied on the opening sale of newly listed securities that are being distributed in an initial public offering (IPO). Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of September 17. (Rel. 34-28423)

#### PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

On September 11, the Commission partially approved a proposed rule change by the <u>Depository Trust Company</u> (SR-DTC-90-08) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act. DTC's proposal increases the adjustable net debit cap of those members that participate in its same-day funds settlement system. Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of September 17. (Rel. 34-28424)

## IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Midwest Securities Trust Company</u> (SR-MSTC-90-05) has filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act. The rule change establishes a service that allows MSTC participants to have securities mailed directly to their clients after a transfer has been effected, and it establishes a fee for this service. Publication of the notice is expected to be made in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> during the week of September 17. (Rel. 34-28425)
