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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS SETTLED AGAINST STOTLER AND COMPANY

The Commission announced the settlement of the previously instituted public proceedings against Stotler and Company of Chicago, Illinois. Stotler, a registered government securities broker-dealer, submitted an offer of settlement in which it consented to a Commission order finding that Stotler wilfully violated certain provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Treasury Rules in that it failed to become a member of a securities association registered under Section 15A of the Exchange Act, failed to have and maintain the required amount of net capital, failed to deposit the required funds in a special reserve bank account for customers, failed to accurately make and keep current records of net capital computations and long and short securities positions, failed to prepare and file financial reports with the Commission, and failed to comply with the telegraphic notice requirements. According to the Order, Stotler had net capital deficiencies of approximately \$11.1 million as of December 31, 1989, \$13.1 million as of April 30, 1990, and \$12 million as of May 31, 1990. Stotler neither admitted nor denied the findings in the Commission's order except for Stotler's incorporation and registration as a government securities brokerdealer.

Stotler's registration as a government securities broker-dealer was revoked. (Rel. 34-28432)

INITIAL DECISION BECOMES FINAL RE JOHN F. GARVAN

On August 24, notice was given pursuant to Rule 17(f) of the Commission's Rules of Practice that the Initial Decision has become final in the matter of John F. Garvan. The order contained in that decision barring John F. Garvan from association with any broker or dealer is declared effective. (Rel. 34-28374)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

RECEIVER APPOINTED FOR 22 DEFENDANTS IN SECURED FINANCE CASE

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that, on September 12, U.S. District Judge Barefoot Sanders appointed a receiver for 22 defendants chared by the Commission in a \$6.7 million ponzi scheme. The receiver is directed to temporarily manage the

businesses of the defendant entities for the protection of the securityholders. Each of the defendants consented to the appointment of the receiver. Also on September 12, the 22 defendant entities and four individual defendants consented, on a neither admit nor deny basis, to an Order of Preliminary Injunction which, amongst other things, freezes their assets.

On September 5, the Commission filed an injunctive action against Maxwell Huffman, James Stewart, James Henry, John Forsberg, and 22 business entities they controlled, charging violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. On September 6, the Court entered a Temporary Restraining Order against all of the defendants. The complaint charges the defendants with fraudulently selling debentures and other debt securities to 172 investors. [SEC v. Maxwell C.
