AGENDA RELEASED FOR EMERGING MARKETS ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING

The Commission released the agenda for today's meeting of the Emerging Markets Advisory Committee.

RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

MULTIJURISDICTIONAL DISCLOSURE SYSTEM WITH CANADA

The Commission is publishing for comment today certain rules, forms and schedules that would permit specified Canadian issuers, through use of Canadian disclosure documents, to register securities under the Securities Act of 1933 and to register securities and report under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. In addition, the multijurisdictional disclosure system would permit compliance with Canadian takeover law to satisfy the Williams Act requirements for certain tender offers made in the United States. In conjunction with the multijurisdictional disclosure system, the Commission also is publishing for comment revisions to certain Commission rules and forms under the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 that would permit Canadian issuers to register securities and report with the Commission on the same basis as all other foreign private issuers. Comments on the multijurisdictional disclosure system proposal are being solicited by the Commission on or before December 15, 1990. FOR MORE INFORMATION, CONTACT: Anita Klein at (202) 272-3246. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

T. ROWE PRICE CALIFORNIA TAX-FREE TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 15, 1990 to request a hearing on an application filed by T. Rowe Price California Tax-Free Trust, et al., under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder, for an order allowing certain investment companies to participate in joint accounts designed to pool cash balances and reserves. Applicants seek to establish three joint accounts: the Commercial Paper Joint Account, which will invest in overnight commercial paper; the Treasury Joint Account, which will invest in repurchase agreements with banks or brokerage houses; and the Tax-Free Joint Account, which will invest in tax-exempt daily variable rate demand notes. FIRST FIDELITY INVESTMENT TRUST FOR RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 19, 1990 to request a hearing on an application filed by First Fidelity Investment Trust For Retirement Accounts for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBUS SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Columbus Southern Power Company (CSPC), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary company, Simco Inc. (Simco), whereby Simco would amend its Articles of Incorporation to reduce the par value and stated capital of its common stock and to return excess capital to CSPC through a declaration of dividends in an aggregate maximum amount of \$4.5 million out of paid-in surplus. CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Consolidated Natural Gas Company (Consolidated), a registered holding company, to extend, through December 31, 1993, the period during which Consolidated may purchase on the open market the 2,423,200 shares of its outstanding common stock, par value \$2.75, remaining of the 4 million shares previously authorized to be purchased through December 31, 1990, and to reissue from time to time, through December 31, 1993, the purchased shares of common stock held as treasury stock to Consolidated's employee benefit plans. ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 13, 1990 to request a hearing on a proposal by Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L), an electric utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company, to enter into installment sales agreements with Pope County, Arkansas to acquire solid waste disposal facilities at AP&L's Nuclear One Generating Station. EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES
