CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES OREGON INVESTMENT ADVISER

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on September 27 the Commission filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon seeking injunctive and other relief against Thomas D. Kienlen Corporation (TDK), a registered investment adviser, and Thomas D. Kienlen. The complaint charges defendants with violating registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws by offering shares of Christos Trust, an investment company which they formed, to clients of TDK before filing a registration statement for Christos. The complaint alleges that the defendants induced several hundred TDK clients to invest about \$7.5 million in Christos by misrepresentations of material facts concerning fund safety, fund operating cost, and the performance of a hypothetical portfolio operated by Kienlen before the Christos registration statement became effective.
