FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT RELEASES

FOIA APPEAL OF BONNIE PAISLEY

The General Counsel sent a letter to Bonnie J. Paisley affirming the Freedom of Information Act Officer's determination to withhold information concerning Summa Medical Corporation. The General Counsel determined that the documents may be withheld pursuant to FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7). (Rel. FOIA-168)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

LARRY GROOVER CONVICTED

The U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah and the SEC announced the conviction of Larry B. Groover, formerly of Salt Lake City, Utah and more recently of Dallas, Texas. Groover, an attorney, was convicted of conspiracy, securities fraud, false statement and mail fraud. Among other things, Groover was convicted of using sham transactions and nominee directors, officers, and shareholders to create a misleading financial picture for G.C. Technologies, Inc., a company listed in the "pink sheets." False financial information and other false documents were used to project the image that G.C. Tech was a company with substantial assets.

Mining leases and oil well leases were obtained by Groover and sold at vastly inflated prices between and among Groover-controlled companies. Groover directed Marvin D. Haney, a certified public accountant, to prepare and audit financial statements for Golden City Exploration, a predecessor of G.C. Tech, for inclusion in the N.Q.B. Form 211 and the SEG Rule 15c2-11 package for G.C. Tech. Haney was not an independent C.P.A. and failed to disclose either that fact or the fact that the assets involved were conveyed to Golden City in related party transactions. [U.S. v. Larry B. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SEAGATE FUNDS
THE DFA DUAL FUND ONE

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that THE SEAGATE FUNDS and THE DFA DUAL FUND ONE, INC. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-17880 - November 27 and IC-17890 - November 30, respectively)

PERMANENT TRUSTEE COMPANY LIMITED

A conditional order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Permanent Trustee Company Limited from Section 17(f) so that it may serve as foreign custodian of securities and other assets of registered investment companies. (Rel. IC-17888; International Series Rel. No. 199 - November 30)

AMERICAN CAPITAL COMSTOCK FUND

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by American Capital Comstock Fund, Inc. et al. (Applicants) under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. (Rel. IC-17889 - November 30)

IDS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 26, 1990 to request a hearing on an application by IDS Life Insurance Company, IDS Life Insurance Company of New York, IDS Life Variable Account for Shearson Lehman (Shearson Account), IDS Life of New York Account 7 (Shearson Account of New York) (collectively, Shearson Accounts), Shearson Lehman Series Fund (Shearson Fund) and IDS Life Series Fund, Inc. (IDS Life Fund) for an order of the Commission, pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act, approving the substitution of shares of certain portfolios of the IDS Life Fund for shares of certain portfolios of the Shearson Fund held by the Shearson Accounts, and, under Section 17(b) of the Act, granting exemptions from Sections 17(a) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the proposed substitution. (IC-17892 - November 30)

PRUDENTIAL CORPORATION PLC

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act permitting Prudential Corporation plc and Prudential Finance (Jersey) Ltd to offer and sell debt securities in the United States without registering as investment companies under the Act. (Rel IC-17893; International Series Rel. No. 200 - December 4)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company (Georgia), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell, through September 1, 1992, up to \$1 billion aggregate principal amount of: (1) short-term notes; (2) term-loan notes; and/or (3) commercial paper (Commercial Paper) in any combination. In addition, Georgia is authorized to enter into interest rate swap and reverse swap agreements (Swaps) covering an underlying principal amount of debt not to exceed \$1 billion. Georgia requests an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under subsection (a)(5) thereunder in connection with the issuance and sale of Commercial Paper and Swaps. (Rel. 35-25197)

TECO ENERGY

An order has been issued authorizing TECO Energy, Inc. (TECO Energy), an exempt public-utility holding company, to acquire up to a 100% interest in Hardee Power Partners Limited, a Florida limited partnership that will become an electric utility company as defined in Section 2(a)(3) of the Act. TECO Energy presently owns 100% of the voting securities of Tampa Electric Company, an electric utility company. (Rel. 35-25199)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of one issue which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rel. 34-28666)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has granted accelerated approval to proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: Pacific Stock Exchange

(SR-PSE-90-42) to extend, for one year, a pilot program governing the activities of alternate specialists on the Exchange's two equity trading floors (Rel. 34-28661); Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-90-29) to amend Exchange Rule 31.5 to provide listing standards for new securities not otherwise covered under existing provisions of the Exchange's listing standards (Rel. 34-28662); and National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-65) to extend for 90 days the SEC's approval of the Pilot Program between the NASD and the International Stock Exchange of the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland, Ltd. consisting of an interchange of quotation information on approximately 740 securities without payment of a separate charge to receive such information (34-28663). Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the weeks of December 3 and 10.

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-90-24) to amend certain of its rules and procedures governing the administration of arbitration at the AMEX (Rel. 34-28664); and National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-61) to amend Schedule D, Part IV of NASD's By-Laws concerning the entry and annual fees charged to issuers whose securities are included in the NASDAQ System (Rel. 34-28665). Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 3.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Cincinnati Stock Exchange</u> (SR-CSE-90-09) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act to amend CSE Rule 11.9(o) that reduces from 30 seconds to 15 seconds the exposure period during which agency orders are exposed to Approved Dealers. Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 3. (Rel. 34-28667)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

On October 11, 1990, the Options Clearing Corporation filed with the Commission a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-90-12) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act relating to fees for its Options News Network Service. The proposal became effective upon filing pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Act. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 10. (Rel. 34-28669)
