## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

#### SEATTLE BROKER BARRED

The Commission accepted an offer of settlement from Andrew L. Evans providing for the simultaneous institution of proceedings, entry of findings and imposition of an administrative sanction against him. The proceedings were based on an admitted finding that during September 1985 Evans had pleaded guilty to and had been convicted of bank fraud charges involving false documents and misapplication of bank funds. The Commission barred Evans from association with any broker or dealer, investment adviser, investment company, municipal securities broker or municipal securities dealer, with the proviso that after the later of the satisfaction completion of the five year probation term to which he was sentenced in connection with his conviction, or June 1, 1991, he may apply to the appropriate regulatory authority to seek readmission to the securities industry.
