INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BT INVESTMENT FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by BT Investment Funds, et al. exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits a series of a registered open-end management investment company to acquire all of the assets and liabilities of a series of another registered open-end management investment company. Because of certain affiliations, applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-24903 – May 25)

COMPOSITE DEFERRED SERIES, INC.

A order has been issued has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Composite Deferred Series, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-24994 – May 25)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES

An order has been issued authorizing Northeast Utilities (NU), a registered holding company, to issue guarantees and other forms of credit support, in an amount not to exceed \$45 million through June 30, 2004, in order to guarantee obligations undertaken by Holyoke Water Power Company (HWP), a utility subsidiary of NU, under a series of reimbursement agreements entered into between HWP and various banks. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-2001-28) relating to the listing and trading of Select Ten Notes. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 28. (Rel. 34-44342)

AMENDMENT TO THE PLAN FOR REPORTING OF CONSOLIDATED OPTIONS LAST SALE REPORTS AND QUOTATION INFORMATION

The Options Price Reporting Authority submitted a proposed amendment to the Plan for Reporting of Consolidated Options Last Sale Reports and Quotation Information (OPRA-2001-02) to permit the options exchanges to disseminate unconsolidated market information to their members, pursuant to Section 11A(a)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 28. (Rel. 34-44347)

JOINT INDUSTRY PLAN

The Commission approved an extension until July 19, 2001, to the Reporting Plan for Nasdaq/National Market Securities Traded on an Exchange on an Unlisted or Listed Basis, (S7-24-89) submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers, the Pacific Exchange, and the Boston, Chicago, Cincinnati, and Philadelphia Stock Exchanges. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 28. (Rel. 34-44348)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the International Securities Exchange to conform its rules to reflect decimal pricing (SR-ISE-2001-14) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 28. (Rel. 34-44349)
