Hormel Foods Corporation (Hormel) respectfully requests an extension of 60 days, to March 4,2002, of the comment period on the docket referenced above.

Hormel is a multinational manufacturer and marketer of consumer branded meat and food products, including meat toppings used on pizza. Accordingly, this proposal has a direct impact on Hormel.

Hormel is currently conducting interviews of consumers regarding their views on meat pizza composition and the changes to the composition contained in this proposal.
