We are writing to thank you for the emergency measures banning the slaughter of downed cattle for human consumption.

PLEASE MAKE THIS BAN PERMANENT!

Please include ALL downed animals: pigs, sheep and other livestock, as well as all downed cattle, in the final ban. Please also add a requirement that all downed animals be humanely euthanized immediately, wherever they become downed.
