General Comment: The USDA should not consider any regulations enabling and promot ing the slaughterhouses of wild horses to operate. Instead they should comply by federally passed legislation that has removed funding for inspection of wild hor ses at slaughterhouses. This legislation was passed with the sole purpose of stoppi ng the slaughter of our valued wild horses as any endangered wild animal in our nation. The preservation of wild horses is as important as that of the eagle ou r national symbol, the spotted owl, the wolf, the buffalo and many other incredibl е animals of our land that have been threatened by our overdevelopment and urge to destroy in the name of profit. I am strongly urging this respect of the history of our great land by preserving the wild horses. Instead the USDA should be enacting regulations to close down all slaughterhouses of wild horses.
