On behalf of my client, Danisco USA Inc., I am writing to request FSIS to formally extend the comment period for the above referenced docket (Docket No. FSIS 2006-0040) for a period of at least 60 days beyond the present comment deadline of January 11, 2007.

The subject matter of the docket, labeling of the term "natural", requires significantly more time to prepare thoughtful comments than the initial time period provided in the docket's Federal Register notice. Very little notice was provided prior to the public meeting held this week on the topic.
