17 This matter is before the Court on the Plaintiff Commodity
 18 Futures Trading Commission's (the "Commission" or "Plaintiff")
 19 application for warrant for arrest of Defendant Jian Zhuang ("Zhuang")
 20 for his failure to comply with this Court's September 15, 2004 Order
 21 Imposing Monetary Sanctions ("Sanctions Order"). On July 29, 2004,
 22 after a hearing and submission of evidence, this Court entered the
 23 Civil Contempt Order. The Order held defendants Zhuang and Emerald in
 24 civil contempt based on a finding by clear and convincing evidence
 25 that they violated the provisions of the Court's November 18, 2003
 26 statutory restraining order by failing to make books, records and

1 other documents available to the Plaintiff, concealing funds subject
2 to an asset freeze, and failing to comply with accounting
3 requirements. In its September 15, 2004 Sanctions Order, the Court
4 found by clear and convincing evidence that coercive sanctions were
5 necessary and imposed daily compliance fines of \$250 against defendant
6 Zhuang and \$200 against defendant Emerald. In that order, the Court
7 noted that should Zhuang fail to pay the daily compliance fine, the
8 Court would entertain a motion by Plaintiff for warrant for arrest.

9 The records of the District Court show that Zhuang has not
10 complied with the September 15, 2004 Sanctions Order, nor has he fully
11 complied with the Civil Contempt Order. It is evident that additional
12 monetary penalty are unlikely to be effective in compelling Zhuang to
13 comply with this Court's orders. It is therefore appropriate that a
14 warrant for Zhuang's arrest be issued in order to bring him before
15 this Court to answer for his contemptuous conduct.

16 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Application for Warrant for
17 Arrest of Defendant Jian Zhuang is hereby **GRANTED**.

18 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the attached warrant shall be
19 issued immediately for the arrest of Zhuang for his failure to obey
20 the Sanctions Order. The warrant for arrest for Zhuang provides that
21 any United States Marshal, or any person authorized by the federal
22 *including (but not limited to) US Customs and Border Control or the "BICE"*
~~government or any state or municipal government~~ to arrest and *ATM*
23 incarcerate a person pursuant to any lawfully issued arrest warrant,
24 shall have the authority to arrest Zhuang and incarcerate Zhuang at
25 the nearest federal detention center.



1 IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that Zhuang shall be brought
2 forthwith before this Court to determine whether he will purge himself
3 of his contemptuous conduct by paying the civil fines imposed by the
4 Sanctions Order and by complying with the Civil Contempt Order.


5 IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that the United States Marshal or
6 other arresting officer shall notify the Court and Plaintiff's
7 attorney of the fact of the arrest of Mr. Zhuang; and

8 IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that Zhuang shall be detained in
9 custody until he is discharged by the Court.


